CRITERIA.

An approved 2024 WT Global License (WT Global Athlete License or Global Official License) is required by all athletes and officials who wish to register for the KASAD 6TH ASIAN TAEKWONDO OPEN CHAMPIONSHIPS 2024.

Senior (Male and Female), **KUKKIWON** Black Belt Only.

COMPETITION RULES & METHOD OF COMPETITION.

Single Elimination System in accordance with the WT Competition Rules and interpretation (In force as of June 13, 2024).

KYORUGI.

- The latest published WT Competition Rules & Interpretation shall be applied.
- Competition Rules :
- Best of 3 System, with 2 (two) minutes x 3 (three) rounds with 1 (one) minutes Break.
- Single Elimination System.
- Grade : G1.
- Seeding and Drawing of lots; For every weight category, regardless of number of athletes all the athletes will be seeded based on WT World Ranking of October.

COMPETITORS AGES

An athlete must be 18 years old or older in the year of KASAD 6th ASIAN TAEKWONDO OPEN CHAMPIONSHIPS 2024.

Athletes who were born in the year of 2006 or before are eligible for participation in the competition.

Senior (Male and Female), 17 years and over (**2007 and before**).

KYORUGI DIVISIONS – WEIGHT CATEGORIES.

Not over / Exceeding means the weight limit is defined by the criterion of one decimal place away from stated limit.

For example, not exceeding 50 kg is established as until 50,0 Kg with 50,1 Kg being over the limit resulting in disqualification.

REGISTRATION.

Registration is only accepted through the WT Event Registration system ;

Website : [http://World Taekwondo \(simplycompete.com\)](http://World Taekwondo (simplycompete.com))

DEADLINE for online registration is **October, 1st 2024.**

- Entry Submissions after this date will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- Late replacement due to injury shall be handled case by case.
- The registered athletes or team officials may be replaced without penalty until October 7th , 2024.
- Entry Fee US \$50 per athlete will not be charged in case of cancellation of participation until October 7th , 2024.
- Entry Fee must be paid in full in case of the notice of cancellation of participating athletes after October 7th , 2024 or no-show.

PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT AND UNIFORM

- The participants shall wear the WT-recognized Taekwondo competition uniform.
- Participating contestants must wear the WT-recognized Competition Uniform. Any contestant who does not wear WT-Approved Kyorugi competition uniform will not be permitted to compete.
- The latest version of WT-recognized manufacturers list is available at the website of WT ; <http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/wtpartners-wt/recognize.html>
- KPnP PSS will be used in this tournament. All athletes must bring their own KPnP sensor socks.
- WT recognized Groin/Fore-arm/Shin Guards/Gloves and Mouth Guards are compulsory and must be brought by the contestants. The Mouthpiece must only be White or Transparent.

ENTRY FEE.

US\$50 per Athlete for Kyorugi Discipline.

The entry fee can be deposited directly to the host county/MNA at the venue, as cash payment.

DEADLINE for online registration is **October, 1st 2024.**

IMPORTANT ;

If the athlete registered online does not take part in the competition for some reason, but he/she has not been removed from their list of participants before the deadline (October 1st, 2024), his/her team officially must fully 100% pay his/her entry fee for the participation.

TECHNICAL DELEGATE AND COMPETITION SUPERVISORY BOARD

The WT will appoint one (1) Technical Delegate and ATU will appoint four (4) members of the Competition Supervisory Board. The following conditions shall apply:

- i. The Organizing Committee shall pay the expenses of room and board for the duration of the competition at least three (3) days before and one (1) day after the tournament.
- ii. The Organizing Committee shall pay a per diem of US\$200 to the Technical Delegate and US\$150 to the members of the Competition Supervisory Board for competition period.

- Check In : Date October 13th, 2024.

- Check Out : Date October 20th, 2024.

INTERNATIONAL REFEREE.

1. The Round-trip airfares shall be borne by each participating International Referee.
2. The Organizing Committee will provide each participating International referee with a daily allowance as per the rules of WT and accommodation.
3. Boarding/Lodging will be provided as below :
 - International Referees
 - Check In : Date October 13th, 2024.
 - Check Out : Date October 18th, 2024.
4. The Organizing Committee shall cover the per diem for International Referees in accordance with the WT Finance Rules.

CLASSIFICATION OF RESULTS / MEDALS / TROPHIES / CERTIFICATES

KYORUGI.

- 1st Place : Gold Medal and Certificate.
- 2nd Place : Silver Medal and Certificate.
- 3rd Place : Bronze Medal and Certificate.
- 3rd Place : Bronze Medal and Certificate.

TEAM AWARDS

- Best Team;
- Male Team (1st, 2nd and 3rd) and Female Team (1st, 2nd and 3rd).

Based on the point system below, the top three (3) teams of the Men's Division and the top three (3) teams of the Women's Division will receive trophies ;

- Basic One (1) point per each contestant who entered the competition area after passing the general weigh-in.
- One (1) point per each win (win by a bye included).
- Additional One Hundred and Twenty (120) points per Gold Medal.
- Additional Fifty (50) points per Silver Medal.
- Additional Twenty (20) points per Bronze Medal.

In case, more than two (2) teams are tied in score, the rank shall be decided by :

1. Number of Gold, Silver and Bronze medals won by the team in order.
2. Number of participating contestants.
3. Higher points in Heavier weight categories.

(Article 6.4 of WT Competition Rules & Interpretation)

All international-level competitions recognized by the WT shall be formed with participating of at least four (4) countries in tournament with no less than four (4) contestants competed in each weight category and any tournament with less than four (4) countries or weight category with less than 4 (four) competed contestant cannot be recognized in the official results.

Accordingly, the points achieved by unrecognized weight categories/divisions will not be included in the Team Standing.

Best Coaches : 2 (two) Coaches - 1 from male team / 1 from female team.

Best Athletes : 1 (one) Male and 1 (one) Female.

Good Fighting Spirit : 2 (two) regardless of gender.

Best Referees : 3 (three) regardless of gender.

Certificate of Participation : it will be given to all participants who participate in this event including the athletes, referees and coaches.

Dress Code for Medallist : all medallist should be dressed as follow during the awards ceremony ; Dobok or National Team Training Suits, Sneakers or Taekwondo Shoes.

DRAW SHEET AND BRACKET PUBLICATION

The draw sheets and brackets will be published after Head of Team meeting and names for random weight-in will be available at 6.00 am every morning.

WEIGH-IN / RANDOM WEIGH-IN

Weigh-in will be done one day prior to the respective weight competition in accordance with the daily schedule mentioned below.

For Random Weigh-in timing will be announced Head of Team Meeting.

The names of the athletes selected for the Random Weigh-in will be published at 06.00 am on the competition day on ATU or the OC website, as well as Whatsapp to the concerned team's manager/coach and will also be displayed / available at the venue.

INDEMNITIES.

1. The respective Participants shall be responsible for ensuring that all officials and participants are covered with effective travel and medical insurance coverage.
2. Participants without proper insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete in the championships.
3. The Organizing Committee will acquire general Public Liability event insurance.

MEDICAL CONTROL.

- i. The WT Anti-Doping Rules, and where necessary the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competitions.

- ii. Compulsory anti-doping tests will be carried out for selected medalists, while random tests will be conducted to the rest of the athletes. The WT and/or WADA may carry out random out of competition testing prior to the championships.
- iii. TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption)

Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the “Prohibited List” of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and Anti-Doping Code of World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) for therapeutic purposes are requested to submit TUE applications via ADAMS, together with the required medical information. If you do not have an ADAMS account yet, please contact tue@ita.sport to have it set up.

Otherwise, please download the TUE Application Form [HERE](#) and once duly completed and signed, send it together with the required medical file to tue@ita.sport with copy to antidoping@worldtaekwondo.org by at least 30 days before the first competition day. TEAM DOCTOR’S MEETING.

In order to receive accreditation card, all registered team doctors or physicians must attend team doctor’s meeting on October 14th 2024.

COACHING REQUIREMENTS.

WT Coach Certificates (Level 1) or above is mandatory for officiating at WT-promoted, sanctioned and recognized competitions.

All coaches must be in good standing with their MNA and holder of a current World Taekwondo Global Valid License.

Coaches will be required to upload a copy their certification to the WT Global License.

For all coaches it is mandatory to wear formal suit when their athletes enter the Semi-Final round and Final round.

HEAD OF MEETING AND DRAWING OF LOTS SESSION.

The Head of Team meeting shall be conducted One (1) days prior to the start of the competition is October 14th, 2024, in the presence of the WT Technical Delegate & ATU officials and the representatives of the participating teams.

At least one representative from each team must be attend the Head of Meeting. In case of no representative can be at the meeting, the team must designate a proxy and inform Technical Delegate or ATU before the meeting.

- Draw will be published on the official ATU/OC website.
- Every participating team is required to bring USB or (CD/DVD) of the Freestyle Poomsae Music at the head of team meeting and submit it to the OC staff.
- Every participating team is required to bring along the following items for use at the Opening and/or Closing ceremonies:
 - Two (2) IOC-recognized national flags, Size: 90cm x 130cm.
 - USB or (CD/DVD) of the pertinent IOC-recognized national anthem.

Additional Notes:

- Participating teams are responsible for confirming their entries before the head of team meeting.
- A certain number of contestants shall be seeded based on the WT Ranking, and it will be announced at the head of the team meeting.

ACCOMODATION AND TRANSPORTATION.

Each team is responsible for cost related to the Accommodation, and Food.

Participating teams are required to submit the hotel reservation to the assigned email of the Organizing Committee by no later than October 1st 2024.

Daily Shuttle Bus between designated/official hotels and venue will be provided for participating teams, if participants stay at a designated hotel by the organizing committee.

Participating teams must submit necessary information, such as date, time of arrival, flight information and so on to the Organizing Committee by no later than October 1st 2024.

SPONSOR IDENTIFICATION.

One (1) sponsor's identification (logo) is allowed to each of Kyorugi dobok's top and bottoms.

The sponsor's identification shall be located within 50 *cm*² except the locatin of WT logo, manufacture's identification, national flag and NOC code.

VISA.

Kindly check to the above-mentioned link for countries that can apply online and those that can have the Visa on Arrival (VoA), approximately 86 countries can get a Visa on Arrival but they have to apply online for an ETA, 72 hours before coming to Indonesia.

For Visa Invitation Letter, contact Indonesia Taekwondo Association so that can help be extended well in time. In case of any discrepancy, the federation will facilitate the visa process for this purpose, anyone can contact the Organizing Committee at admin@taekwondo.or.id.

The deadline for Visa application form is October 1st 2024.

ATHLETE REPLACEMENT

In the event that the registered athletes should be replaced by another due to injuries, the participants can officially request to the ATU for the replacement by **no later than October 1st 2024** by submitting 'Athlete Late Replacement Form' together with certification from the medical doctor in the language of the pertinent country and also in English to admin@asiantu.org and admin@taekwondo.or.id The decision on the acceptance will be made after evaluation of the submitted documents.
