In accordance with Article 4: Qualification of Contestant and Article 22: WT Para Taekwondo Competition Rules, the contestant must be:

CRITERION #1: Holder of the nationality of the participating team

CRITERION #2: An athlete must be nominated by the pertinent national taekwondo association that is recognized by the World Taekwondo

CRITERION #3: Holder of Taekwondo 5-1 Gup recognized by WT MNA or Dan/Poom certificate issued by the Kukkiwon or WT (* A copy of the Poom or Dan certificate should be enclosed when registering for accreditation. In case a contestant has applied for a Kukkiwon Dan certificate but has not received it yet, a copy of the Dan application form and the remittance certificate sent to the Kukkiwon must be enclosed when registering for accreditation. Please refer to the Kukkiwon Web site (www.kukkiwon.or.kr) for more information.

Notice: The 5th African Para Taekwondo Open Championships will be open to participation from all WT MNAs. G4 World Ranking points will be awarded to WTAF athletes while athletes from other continents will be awarded G2 World Ranking points

CRITERION #5: An athlete must be at the age of at least 16 years old of the 5th African Para Taekwondo Open Championships. Athlete must be born before December 31st, 2005.)

CRITERION#6: Athlete must go through International Classification in accordance with the WT Athlete Classification Rules and be assigned a Sport Class and Sport Class Status prior to the tournament.

Qualifications for Coaches :

CRITERION#1: As it is a G4/G2 Para Taekwondo Competition, it is Mandatory that all coaches have a Level 2 World Para Taekwondo Coach Certification.

- 9. REGISTRATION AND WT GLOBAL LICENCE:
 - Registration is only accepted through the WT Event Registration system <u>https://worldtkd.simplycompete.com/events</u> and registration is only possible with a valid 2022 WT Global License. The following documents are required for all participants to be uploaded and Approved by the National Federation and WT before you can register your team through the WT Event Registration System. For ALL participants (athletes and officials)
 - 2. Valid National ID or Passport of the National Federations you are registering for a WT Global License.
 - 3. WT Signed Event Liability Waiver (page 3 only) valid for 5 years
 - 4. Color Portrait ID picture.
 - 5. To register a <u>Doctor</u> Proof of Medical Doctor/Physio therapist certificate in <u>English</u>
 - 6. All Athletes and Team officials must FIRST be registered with a WT Licence
 - 7. Entry Registration: Entry will only be accepted through the WT online registration system WT GMS.

Notice: There will be "NO" WT Global License registration onsite. Please be sure you have valid GAL before you register.





10. ENTRY FEES

Entry fees: The OC shall collect the entry fees from the participating national teams. The national team shall pay an entry fee to the Organizing Committee in cash US\$100 only at the accreditation center prior to the start of the Championships. Athletes shall not be allowed to compete without successful payment of entry fee to the Organizing Committee.

1. Registration Fees: US \$100 per athlete.

11. ENTRY DEADLINES & IMPORTANT DATES

1. Entry deadline is January 20th, 2022. Entry submission after this date will be not accepted under any circumstances. Late replacement due to injury shall be handled case by case.

Athletes:

Member National Association can submit entry for an unlimited number of athletes. No entry will be accepted or modified during on-spot registration.

Team officials:

Member National Association can submit entry for maximum one (1) Head of team per country, one (1) manager per team, two (2) coaches per team, one (1) team doctor per team, one (1) trainer per team, one. (1) Athlete assistant per 5 athletes on a team. US\$100 will be charged per team official in case of onsite registration without prior entry submission until January 20th, 2022.

Notice: There will be no WT Global License registration onsite. Please be sure you have valid GAL before you register.

12. CLASSIFICATION

Kyorugi

Only athletes with a new or review sports class status will be classified. Classification will be held on February 2nd, 2022. A schedule for teams and athletes will be set up by the WT in consultation with the African Union Taekwondo/OC and communicated to all teams following closing of registrations.

Athletes that have gone through classification and been given the sport class status Not Eligible (NE) cannot compete in WT Para Taekwondo world ranking events.

Medical Diagnostics From through World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS)

Following IPC Guidelines on data protection concerning athletes and personal classification information. World Taekwondo has in connection with IPC created the World Taekwondo





Classification System (WTCS). World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS) is our new online registration tool for MNAs to register their new athletes and add Medical Diagnostic Forms (MDF) and pictures to be seen by our Classification Evaluation Committee in order to determine if the new athlete is eligible for Para Taekwondo and meets Minimum Impairment Criteria (MIC). All athletes in the WTCS will require a WT License Number (GAL).

WTCS Account Policy – Each Member Federation must internally designate exactly one (1) primary user responsible for WTCS Account.

1.3 Weigh in of Kyorugi athletes will be held the day before competition.

*Athletes that has gone through classification and been given the sport class status Not Eligible (NE)

cannot compete in WT Para Taekwondo world ranking events.

14. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

- 1) Round trip airfare and accommodation: Round trip airfare and accommodation charges of room and board shall be borne by the participating Member National Association.
- 2) Entry fees: The OC shall collect the entry fees from the participating national teams. The national team shall pay an entry fee to the Organizing Committee in cash US\$100 only at the accreditation center in Niamey prior to the start of the Championships. Athletes shall not be allowed to compete without successful payment of entry fee to the Organizing Committee
- 3) Ground Transportation: Ground transportation will be provided for national teams on arrival and departure from and to International Airport Diori Hamani only, provided that the Organizing Committee has been informed of the date, time, and flight schedule of the national team at the latest by the designated deadline May 20, 2021. The Organizing Committee will also provide ground transportation to and from all Official hotels, training venue and the venue provided that the national teams stay at the Official hotels.

16. WT-RECOGNIZED TAEKWONDO UNIFORM (DOBOK) AND PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- Participating contestants are required to wear WT-recognized doboks* and WTrecognized protective equipment. The latest version of WT-recognized manufacturers' list is available at the website of WT
- 2) (<u>http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/recognized</u>).
- 3) The Organizing Committee will provide head protector and Protector and Scoring System (PSS) to the participating contestants. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthpieces, gloves, sensing socks and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.
- 4) Before entering the field of play, all contestants will proceed to the inspection desk for inspection of their doboks and protective equipment. Any contestant who wears unofficial doboks or protective equipment will not be permitted to compete.
- 17. ANTI-DOPING
 - 1) The WT Anti-Doping Rules, and where necessary the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competitions.
 - 2) Random anti-doping tests will be carried out during the competitions. The WT and/or WADA may carry out random out-of competition testing prior to the championships.
 - 3) TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption) Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the "Prohibited List" of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and Anti-Doping Code of World Anti-Doping

Agency (WADA) are requested to visit the website of WADA and make online filing of their TUE applications on ADAMS http://www.wada-ama.org/en/ADAMS/ and report to the WT Sports Division at <u>sport@worldtaekwondo.org</u> by no later than February 1, 2022.
