In accordance with *Article 4: Qualification of Contestant* of the WT Competition Rules, the contestant must be:
- 
- CRITERION #1:** Holder of the nationality of the participating team
- CRITERION #2:** An athlete must be nominated by the pertinent national taekwondo association that is recognised by the World Taekwondo
- CRITERION #3:** Holder of the Kukkiwon Poom or Dan Certificate  
(\*A copy of the Dan certificate should be uploaded to GMS prior to registration for the event. In case a contestant has applied for a Kukkiwon Dan certificate but has not received it yet, a copy of the Dan application form and the remittance certificate sent to the Kukkiwon must be uploaded to GMS prior to registration for the event. Please refer to the Kukkiwon Web site ([www.kukkiwon.or.kr](http://www.kukkiwon.or.kr)) for more information.)
- CRITERION #4:** An athlete must be 17 years old or older in the year of the 26<sup>th</sup> Asian Taekwondo Championships. Athletes who were born in the year of 2007 or before are eligible for participation in the competition.
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**CRITERION #5:** Holder of the WT Global Athlete License (GAL)

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**7. COMPETITION RULES**

The latest published WT Competition Rules & Interpretation shall be applied.

**8. METHOD OF COMPETITION**

- i. Single elimination system
- ii. Grade: G4
- iii. Seeding and drawing of lots: For every weight category, regardless of number of athletes all the athletes will be seeded based on WT World Ranking of May 2024.

**9. CONTEST TIME**

Best of 3 system [2 minutes x 2 (3) rounds with 1 minute break]

- ii. Possible Maximum Quotas per Division
  - The Wild Card invitation is available for ONE athlete per country in each of Kyorugi categories (Only 1 athlete per weight category per MNA.)
  - 6 Weigh Categories (Each male & female)
  - 8 Wild Card Quotas

➔ **Total: 14 Categories (Each male & female)**

➔ **Points gained by the wildcard athlete shall not be included in the team score.**

**11. CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATING TEAMS**

- i. Round-trip Airfare and Accommodation  
 Round trip airfare and accommodation charges of room and board shall be borne by the participating Member National Association.

**12. WT GLOBAL LICENCE & ONLINE REGISTRATION**

- i. WT Global License Registration  
 All Athletes and Team officials must FIRST be registered with a WT Global Athlete License (GAL) or Global Official License (GOL).

ii. WT Online Registration

National Team Entry will only be accepted through the WT online registration system and registration is only possible with a valid WT Global License. National Team GMS admins will be notified via email once online registration is open. All athletes and officials must be registered under team name “Country Name National Team”, for example “Vietnam National Team”

**13. ENTRY FEES: USD 100 per athlete**

- i. The OC shall collect the entry fees from the participating national teams. The national team shall pay an entry fee to the Organizing Committee by bank transfer or in cash in US\$ at the accreditation center at the host hotel(Grand Mercure Danang) prior to the Head of Team meeting. Athletes shall not be allowed to compete without successful payment of entry fee to the Organizing Committee.

**14. ENTRY DEADLINES & IMPORTANT DATES**

- i. **Entry deadline is April 20, 2024 GMT +7 (Ha Noi time).** Entry submissions after this date/time will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- ii. Late replacement due to injury shall be handled case by case.
- iii. The registered athletes or team officials may be replaced **without penalty until April 30, 2024.**
- iv. Entry fee of US\$ 100 per athlete will not be charged in case of cancellation of participation until April 30, 2024
- v. Entry fee must be paid in full in case of the notice of cancellation of participating athletes after April 30, 2024 or no-show.

Athletes: Member National Associations can submit entries for a maximum of six (6) male and six (6) female athletes. One (1) athlete per weight category. No entry will be accepted or modified at the accreditation center in Da Nang, Viet Nam

Team officials: Member national association can register online for maximum one (1) Head of team per country, one (1) manager per team, three (3) coaches per team, three (3) team medical staffs per team, two (2) trainers per team and three (3) guests per country.

In case of exceeding this number, US\$100 will be charged per person before issuance of the accreditation card. US\$100 will be charged per team official registered onsite and per change made to the registered team.

**Any WT Global Licence registration completed onsite will be charged a \$50 extra onsite processing fee for each WT Global Licence.**

## 16. CLASSIFICATION OF RESULTS

## 17. INTERNATIONAL REFEREES

The ATU will appoint a total of thirty five (35) International Referee. The appointed international referees shall officiate at the 26<sup>th</sup> Asian Taekwondo Championships; the following conditions shall apply:

- International Referees are required to pay for their own round-trip airfares.

- ii. The Organizing Committee shall pay the expenses of room and board for the duration of the competition at least two (2) days before and one (1) day after the tournament.
- iii. The Organizing Committee shall pay a per diem of US\$150 to the selected International Referees for each working day.
- iv. The OC will facilitate local transportation between the airport, designated hotel and competition venue.

#### 18. TECHNICAL DELEGATE AND COMPETITION SUPERVISORY BOARD

The WT will appoint one (1) Technical Delegate and ATU will appoint four (4) members of the Competition Supervisory Board. The following conditions shall apply:

- i. The Organizing Committee shall pay the expenses of room and board for the duration of the competition at least three (3) days before and one (1) day after the tournament.
- ii. The Organizing Committee shall pay a per diem of US\$200 to the Technical Delegate and US\$150 to the members of the Competition Supervisory Board for competition period.

#### 19. WT-RECOGNIZED TAEKWONDO COMPETITION UNIFORM AND PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- i. **KPNP Protector and Scoring System (PSS) including PSS Headgear** will be used for the Championships.
- ii. Participating contestants are required to wear WT-recognized competition uniform and WT-recognized protective equipment. The latest version of WT recognized manufacturers' list is available at the website of WT  
<http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/wtpartners-wt/recognize.html>
- iii. The Organizing Committee will provide Protectors and Scoring System (PSS) to the participating contestants. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthpieces, gloves, sensing socks and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.
- iv. Before entering the field of play, all contestants will proceed to the inspection desk for inspection of their competition uniforms and protective equipment. **Any contestant who wears unofficial competition uniforms or protective equipment will not be permitted to compete.**
- v. The top has to cover completely the buttocks. However, the bottom of top should be more than 15 cm above the knee cap.
- vi. Instant Video Replay (IVR) System will be used.
- vii. Wireless communication system between center referee and review jury will be used.

#### 20. IDENTIFICATION OF NOC CODE AND MANUFACTURER

- i. National flag shall be located between 3 to 3.5cm below from the shoulder line of the right arm.
- ii. NOC Code is a three-letter National Olympic Committee abbreviation, and **it must be printed at the back in black** and centered at 5 cm or higher from the bottom line of the upper garment within the size of 30cm width x 12cm height. The font of the letters shall be in bold "Verdana".
- iii. Manufacturer's identifications (name, designation trademark, logo or any distinctive sign of the manufacturer) shall be located one for the top within 30cm<sup>2</sup> and between 3 to 3.5cm below the shoulder line of the left arm, one for bottoms or within 30cm<sup>2</sup> located above the knee and center of the right leg, and one for Kyorugi belt within 6cm<sup>2</sup> at the end of the belt.

#### 21. SPONSOR'S IDENTIFICATION

- i. ONE sponsor's identification (logo) is allowed to each of competition uniform's top and bottoms.

- ii. The sponsor's identification shall be located within 50cm<sup>2</sup> except the location of WT logo, manufacturer's identification, national flag, and NOC code.

## 22. MEDICAL CONTROL

- i. The WT Anti-Doping Rules, and where necessary the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competitions.
- ii. Compulsory anti-doping tests will be carried out for selected medalists, while random tests will be conducted to the rest of the athletes. The WT and/or WADA may carry out random out of competition testing prior to the championships.
- iii. TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption)  
Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the "Prohibited List" of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and Anti-Doping Code of World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) for therapeutic purposes are requested to submit TUE applications via ADAMS, together with the required medical information. If you do not have an ADAMS account yet, please contact [tue@ita.sport](mailto:tue@ita.sport) to have it set up.  
Otherwise, please download the TUE Application Form [HERE](#) and once duly completed and signed, send it together with the required medical file to [tue@ita.sport](mailto:tue@ita.sport) with copy to [antidoping@worldtaekwondo.org](mailto:antidoping@worldtaekwondo.org) by at least 30 days before the first competition day. ## 23. HEAD OF TEAM MEETING & DRAWING OF LOTS

- i. The head of team meeting shall be conducted one (1) day prior to the start of the 1st day of competition, in the presence of the ATU officials and the representatives of the participating nations.
- ii. At least one representative from each team must attend the head of team meeting. In case no representative can attend the meeting, the team must designate a proxy and inform the technical delegate or ATU before the meeting.
- iii. Drawing of lots will take place each day following the completion of General Weigh-in. The draw will be published on the official ATU/OC website.
- iv. Every participating MNA is required to bring along the following items for use at the Opening and/or Closing, and Awarding ceremonies:
  - + Two (2) IOC-recognized national flags, Size: 90cm x 130cm
  - + USB of the pertinent IOC-recognized national anthem Additional

### Notes:

- Participating teams are responsible for confirming their entries before the head of team meeting.
- A certain number of contestants shall be seeded based on the WT Ranking, and it will be announced at the head of the team meeting.

## 24. WEIGH-IN

- i. General weigh-in of the contestants shall take place on the day before their respective weight category.
- ii. Random weigh-in of the contestants shall take place in the morning on the competition day of their respective weight category except M+87 & W+73.
- iii. Random weigh-in shall apply to following number of athletes with 5% allowance as below tables.

- iv. During the weigh-in, male contestants shall wear underpants and female contestants shall wear underpants and brassieres. However, contestants may weigh-in in the nude if they want to do so.

## 25. INDEMNITIES

- i. The respective national taekwondo associations shall be responsible for ensuring that all officials and participants are covered with effective travel & medical insurance coverage.
- ii. Participants without proper insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete in the championships.
- iii. The Organizing Committee will acquire general Public Liability event insurance.

## 26. ACCOMMODATION & TRANSPORTATION

The participating teams are required to submit the hotel reservation only via the VIET NAM TAEKWONDO FEDERATION [tkdvn1996@gmail.com](mailto:tkdvn1996@gmail.com) by April 20, 2024. Due to number of uprising demand of high season it is recommended to make booking and payment on time. Teams shall pay an accommodation fee to the Organizing Committee via transfer or with cash in US\$ at the Venue.

50% of total amount must be paid till April 20, 2024 (upon bank transfer)

Total amount must be paid till April 30, 2024

Teams booked hotels via federation will be provided transportation. And it is sure that the OC will help Team Members to obtain entry visas into Viet Nam.

Local transportation is also provided in Da Nang City

- i. Between all official hotels and the registration center
- ii. Daily transportation shuttle service between all official hotels and the competition venue on competition days
- iii. Daily transportation shuttle service between official hotels and training venues on training days prior to the event
- iv. Transportation shuttle service between official hotels and competition venue for athletes attending the weigh in



## 27. VISA INFORMATION

The Organizing Committee can provide invitation letters for visa applications. However, MNAs are required to check the Viet Nam entry visa application waiting time in their own countries and submit requests for invitation letters to the Organizing Committee.

The Organizing Committee can guarantee entry into Viet Nam if MNAs submit the entry visa form before April 20, 2024.

It is the responsibility of each athlete and MNA to apply for and secure the correct entry visa for Viet Nam.

MNAs are requested to complete the attached visa application form at least two weeks before the waiting time deadline in their own country.

The visa invitation letter from OC will be sent within 7 working days after request, yet the other visa invitation letter with bar code issued by Viet Nam Government will be sent in 15 working days.

## 28. ATHLETE REPLACEMENT

In the event that the registered athletes should be replaced by another due to injuries, the Member National Association can officially request to the ATU for the replacement by **no later than April 30, 2024** by submitting 'Athlete Late Replacement Form' together with certification from the medical doctor in the language of the pertinent country and also in English to [admin@wtasia.org](mailto:admin@wtasia.org) and [tkdvn1996@gmail.com](mailto:tkdvn1996@gmail.com). The decision on the acceptance will be made after evaluation of the submitted documents.

## 29. COACH'S REQUIREMENTS

All coaches are required to hold WT Coach Certificate Level II(2). **Coaches those do not hold Level II coach certificates will be deleted from the registration and not allowed to coach at the Championships.**

All coaches are required to wear formal suit such as tie, jacket, dress shirt (long or short), and trousers, and sport shoes during Semi-Finals and Finals. Any type of cap/hat is not allowed. If any coach refuses to wear the above mentioned attire, he or she will not be allowed to coach for this championship.
