- 6. QUALIFICATIONS**
In accordance with *Article 4: Qualification of Contestant* of the WT Competition Rules, the contestant must be:
 - CRITERION #1:** Holder of the nationality of the participating team
 - CRITERION #2:** Holder of WT recognized Dan or 5-1 Geup
 - CRITERION #3:** **An athlete must be 16 years old or older.** An athlete who was born in the year of 2010 or before is eligible to participate in the competition.
 - CRITERION #4:** Holder of the WT Global Athlete License (GAL) valid in 2026.*
 - CRITERION #5:** Athlete must go through International Classification in accordance with the WT Athlete Classification Rules and be assigned a Sport Class and Sport Class Status prior to the tournament. Athletes found Not Eligible (NE) or with a Classification Not Complete (CNC) will not be able to compete.

7. COMPETITION RULES

The latest World Para Taekwondo (WPT) Competition Rules & Interpretation shall be applied.

8. METHOD OF COMPETITION

- i. Single elimination system
- ii. Grade: G3
- iii. Seeding and drawing of lots: All ranked athletes based on August 2026 World Para Taekwondo Ranking shall be seeded accordingly.

9. CONTEST TIME

Best of 3 system [2 minutes x 2 (3) rounds with 1 minute break]

10. WEIGHT CATEGORIES

11. WT GLOBAL LICENCE & ONLINE REGISTRATION

- i. WT Global License Registration
All Athletes and Team officials must FIRST be registered with a WT Global Athlete License (GAL) or Global Official License (GOL).
- ii. WT Online Registration
Participating Team Entry will only be accepted through the WT online registration system and registration is only possible with a valid WT Global License. Participating Team GMS admins will be notified via email once online registration is open.

12. ENTRY FEES: USD US\$ 100 per athlete

- i. The OC shall collect the entry fees from the participating teams. The participating team shall pay an entry fee to the Organizing Committee via Bank or with cash in US\$ at the accreditation center(s) in the Main Hotel and/or at the Venue, prior to the Head of Team meeting. Athletes shall not be allowed to compete without successful payment of entry fee to the Organizing Committee.

REGULAR ENTRY FEE period will end on 09 August 2026.

**** At the close of regular registration of 09 August 2026, if the Organizing Committee and the ATU decide to implement an extension of the Registration Period, this will be advertised by an official communication and then the following late registration dates and fees will apply ****

LATE REGISTRATION FEES: In case that a late registration period is required the national teams completing their registration during this period will be charged this fee.

- **US\$ 150** per athlete
- Late registration fee period would begin on 10 August 2026.
- Late registration period will end (if implemented) on **14 August 2026**.

LATE REGISTRATION PERIOD ONLY APPLIES IF THE ATU AND OC DECIDE TO IMPLEMENT THIS AND IF SO, THIS WILL BE INFORMED BY THE ATU OR OC IN AN OFFICIAL COMMUNICATION.

13. ENTRY DEADLINES & IMPORTANT DATES

- Entry deadline is 09 August 2026.** Entry submissions after this date/time will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- Late replacement due to injury shall be handled case by case.
- The registered athletes or team officials may be **replaced without penalty until 09 August 2026**.
- Entry fee of 50% per athlete will not be charged in case of **cancellation** of participation till 09 August 2026.
- Entry fee must be paid in full in case of the **notice of cancellation** of participating athletes after 09 August 2026_or no-show.

14. CLASSIFICATION OF RESULTS

- Individual Awards
Medals will be awarded to the top four athletes in the respective weight category of the pertinent championships:

1st PLACE:	GOLD MEDAL & CERTIFICATE
2nd PLACE:	SILVER MEDAL & CERTIFICATE
3rd PLACE:	BRONZE MEDAL & CERTIFICATE
3rd PLACE:	BRONZE MEDAL & CERTIFICATE

- Best Athletes
- Male 1 / Female 1
- Good Fighting Spirit
- 2 regardless of gender

3. Best Referees

- 2 regardless of gender

** Certificate of Participation

- It will be given to all participants who participate in this event including the athletes, referees and coaches.

** Dress Code for medalists

- All medalists should be dressed as follows during the awards ceremony.
 - >Dobok or Training suits
 - > Sneakers or Taekwondo shoes

15. TECHNICAL DELEGATE AND COMPETITION SUPERVISORY BOARD

The WT will appoint one (1) Technical Delegate and ATU will appoint four (4) members of the Competition Supervisory Board. The following conditions shall apply:

- The Organizing Committee shall pay the expenses of room and board for the duration of the competition at least three (3) days before and one (1) day after the tournament.
- The Organizing Committee shall pay a per diem of US\$200 to the Technical Delegate and US\$150 to the members of the Competition Supervisory Board for competition period.

16. WT-RECOGNIZED TAEKWONDO COMPETITION UNIFORM AND PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- KPNP K2 Protector and Scoring System (PSS) including PSS Headgear** will be used for the Championships.
- Participating contestants are required to wear **WT-recognized competition uniform** and WT-recognized protective equipment. The latest version of WT recognized manufacturers' list is available at the website of WT <https://www.worldtaekwondo.org/officialsuppliers/Recognition/contents>
- The Organizing Committee will provide Protector and Scoring System (PSS) to the participating contestants. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthpieces, gloves, sensing socks and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.
- Before entering the field of play, all contestants will proceed to the inspection desk for inspection of their competition uniforms and protective equipment. **Any contestant who wears unofficial competition uniforms or protective equipment will not be permitted to compete.**
- The top has to cover completely the buttocks. However, the bottom of top should be more than 15cm above the knee cap.
- Instant Video Replay (IVR) System will be used.

17. SPONSOR'S IDENTIFICATION

- ONE sponsor's identification (logo) is allowed to each of competition uniform's top and bottoms.
- The sponsor's identification shall be located within 50cm² except the location of WT logo, manufacturer's identification, national flag, and NOC code.

18. MEDICAL CONTROL

- The WT Anti-Doping Rules, and where necessary the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competitions.

- ii. Compulsory anti-doping tests will be carried out for selected medalists, while random tests will be conducted to the rest of the athletes. The WT and/or WADA may carry out random out of competition testing prior to the championships.
- iii. TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption)
Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the "Prohibited List" of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and Anti-Doping Code of World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) for therapeutic purposes are requested to submit TUE applications via ADAMS, together with the required medical information. If you do not have an ADAMS account yet, please contact tue@ita.sport to have it set up.
Otherwise, please download the TUE Application Form [HERE](#) and once duly completed and signed, send it together with the required medical file to tue@ita.sport with copy to antidoping@worldtaekwondo.org by at least 30 days before the first competition day. 19. CLASSIFICATION

Classification will be held on August 20, 2026.

Medical Diagnostic Form: Medical Diagnostic Form (MDF), along with a picture in anatomical position, must be submitted for any NEW (N) or REVIEW (R) athletes registered for the tournament. The deadline for uploading documents to the WTCS is the registration deadline (09 August 2026).

If no MDF has been submitted by the deadline, the athlete will not be called for classification and cannot compete.

World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS) is the WT online registration tool for MNAs to register their new athletes and upload Medical Diagnostic Forms (MDF) and other necessary documentation to be reviewed by the WT Classification Evaluation Committee to determine if the new athlete is eligible for Para Taekwondo and meets Minimum Impairment Criteria (MIC). All athletes in the WTCS will require a WT License Number (GAL).

20. HEAD OF TEAM MEETING & DRAWING OF LOTS

- i. The head of team meeting shall be conducted as given in the schedule, in the presence of the ATU officials and the representatives of the participating nations.
- ii. At least one representative from each team must attend the head of team meeting. In case no representative can attend the meeting, the team must designate a proxy and inform the technical delegate or ATU before the meeting.
- iii. Drawing of lots will take place each day following the completion of General Weigh-in. The draw will be published on the official ATU/OC website.

- iv. Every participating team is required to bring along the following items for use at the Opening and/or Closing, and Awarding ceremonies:
- + Two (2) IOC-recognized national flags, Size: 90cm x 130cm
 - + USB or (CD/DVD) of the pertinent IOC-recognized national anthem
- Additional Notes:
- Participating teams are responsible for confirming their entries before the head of team meeting.
 - A certain number of contestants shall be seeded based on the WT Ranking, and it will be announced at the head of the team meeting.

21. WEIGH-IN

- i. General weigh-in of the contestants shall take place on the day before their respective weight category.
- ii. Random weigh-in of the contestants shall take place in the morning on the competition day of their respective weight category except M+80 & W+65.
- iii. Random weigh-in shall apply to following number of athletes with 5% allowance as below tables.

Number of contestants in weight category	Number (%) of random weigh-in contestants
More than 32	20%
17-32	6
9-16	4
4-8	2
Below 4	0

- iv. During the weigh-in, male contestants shall wear underpants and female contestants shall wear underpants and brassieres. However, contestants may weigh-in in the nude if they want to do so.

22. INDEMNITIES

- i. Participants without proper insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete in the championships.
- ii. The Organizing Committee will acquire general Public Liability event insurance.

23. ACCOMMODATION & TRANSPORTATION

The participating teams are required to submit the hotel reservation only via the forms provided on WT GMS and email the forms along with other information to Pakistan Taekwondo Federation by **28 Jul 2026**. Due to number of uprising demands of high season it is recommended to make booking and payment on time. Teams shall pay an entry fee to the Organizing Committee via transfer or with cash in US\$ at the Venue.

Teams booked hotels via federation will be provided transportation.

Local transportation is also provided in Lahore.

- i. Between all official hotels and the registration center
- ii. Daily transportation shuttle service between all official hotels and the competition venue on competition days
- iii. Daily transportation shuttle service between official hotels and training venues on training days prior to the event
- iv. Transportation shuttle service between official hotels and venue for athletes attending the weigh-in

BOARDING & LODGING WAIVER CRITERIA

The first 10 National Teams to register exactly 10 athletes according to the following breakdown will receive a full boarding and lodging waiver:

- Poomsae: Minimum 4 athletes
- Kyorugi: Minimum 4 athletes
- Para-Kyorugi: Minimum 2 athletes

Important Note

- Teams must have exactly 10 athletes fitting this criteria to qualify. No partial waivers will be given for fewer than 10 athletes. Any extra athletes beyond the initial 10 must pay full price for accommodation and meals.
- **This waiver applies only to teams that actually compete in the event. Teams that register but do not participate will be disqualified from the waiver.**
- **Hotel room assignments operate on a first-come, first-served basis.**
- National Teams that meet the above conditions shall stay at the hotel designated by the Organizing Committee.

To avail this facility National Teams must first register through WT SimplyCompete and then send a formal request to ATU (copying OC), get the confirmation from ATU & OC for the waiver. Please be advised that waivers will be processed strictly in the order official email requests are received. Teams that fail to send an email request will not be eligible for the waiver, even if the registration criteria are met.

24. VISA INFORMATION

Kindly check the above-mentioned link for countries that can apply online and those that can have the Visa on Arrival (<https://visa.nadra.gov.pk/list-of-countries-for-visa-prior-to-arrival/>) (approximately 126 countries can get a visa on arrival, apply 24 hours before departure). All other countries must apply for an online visa at <https://visa.nadra.gov.pk/other-visa/> (6 weeks before the start of the event).

For Visa Invitation Letter, contact PTF Secretariat office so the help can be extended well in time. In case of any discrepancy, the Federation will facilitate the visa process, for this purpose, anyone can contact OC at ptf_wasim@yahoo.com.

25. ATHLETE REPLACEMENT

In the event that the registered athletes should be replaced by another due to injuries, the participants can officially request to the ATU for the replacement by **no later than 09 August 2026** by submitting 'Athlete Late Replacement Form' together with certification from the

medical doctor in the language of the pertinent country and also in English to admin@asiantu.org and ptf_wasim@yahoo.com. The decision on the acceptance will be made after evaluation of the submitted documents.

26. COACH'S REQUIREMENTS

All coaches are required to hold WT Coach Certificate Level II. **Coaches those do not hold Level-II coach certificate will be deleted from the registration and not allowed to coach at the Championships.**

All coaches are required to wear formal suit such as tie, jacket, dress shirt (long or short), and trousers, and sport shoes during Semi-Finals and Finals. Any type of cap/hat is not allowed. If any coach refuses to wear abovementioned attire, he or she will not be allowed to coaching for this championship.
