1. Athlete Participation Requirements:

In accordance with Article 4: Competitor Qualification of the WT Competition Rules, the competitor must:

Criterion 1: Be a Taekwondo Black Belt.

Criterion 2: WT 2026 Global Athlete License (GAL).

Criterion 3: All coaches must have WT Level 1 certification.

2. Categories and Age:

Adult: 17 years or older (born in 2009 or earlier)

Junior: 15–17 years (born in 2009–2011)

Cadet: 12–14 years (born in 2012–2014)

3. Competition Rules:

The latest updated WT Competition Rules shall apply.

4. Competition Method:

Kyorugui and Para Taekwondo

Single Elimination System, best of three (3) rounds;

Poomsae

Recognized Poomsae: Single Elimination System (Side by Side);

Freestyle Poomsae: Cutt-off System (There will be only one round of competition, which will be conducted as a direct final. No qualification round or elimination cuts will be held);

All Freestyle songs must be submitted before the technical congress;

7. International Classification

All teams should prepare their travel for their athletes to be available for International Classification on these dates.

The WT Para Taekwondo Department will publish the Classification time schedule after the deadline expires.

The details on each sport class can be found in the WT Athlete Classification Rules on the WT website.

Medical Diagnostics Form through World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS)

Medical Diagnostic Form must be submitted for any NEW (N) or REVIEW (R) athlete registered for the tournament. The deadline for uploading MDFs to the WTCS is on the registration deadline (Jan 26). If no MDF has been submitted by this time the athlete will not be called for classification and cannot compete.

Following IPC Guidelines on data protection concerning athletes and personal classification information, World Taekwondo has in connection with IPC created the World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS). World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS) is the new WT online

registration tool for MNAs to register their new athletes and add Medical Diagnostic Forms (MDF) and pictures to be seen by the WTClassification Evaluation Committee to determine if the new athlete is eligible for Para Taekwondo and meets Minimum Impairment Criteria (MIC). All athletes in the WTCS will require a WT License Number (GAL).

In order to activate Member National Association user account information for the World Para Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS) please click on WTCS Account Request Form on the following link: <https://db.ipc-services.org/wtcs/app/login>. Fill out and submit the MNA Account Request form to the ParaTaekwondo Department at para-tkd@worldtaekwondo.org. Username and password will then be sent to the communicated email address.

WTCS Account Policy – Each Member Federation must internally designate exactly one (1) primary user responsible for WTCS Account.

8. Team Registration:

Entries will only be accepted through the WT GMS online registration system. Athlete registration is only possible with a valid WT 2026 Global License (GAL issued only by assigned club, region and GMS MNA administrators). 9. Entry Fee:

The Organizing Committee shall collect entry fees in U.S. Dollars (USD) upon on-site registration at the competition venue. Alternatively, payment may be made in Brazilian Reais (BRL), based on the official exchange rate applicable on the day of payment. No other form of payment shall be accepted. Registered athletes and coaches will not be allowed to participate in the competition without payment. The Organizing Committee maintains a NO REFUND policy under any circumstances.

10. International Referees:

PATU shall appoint a total of thirty (30) International Referees and ten (10) national Referees, in addition to the PATU Referee Chairman. The designated International Referees shall officiate at the Brazil Open G2 under the following conditions:

- International Referees shall be responsible for their own round-trip airfare.
- The Organizing Committee shall cover five (5) nights of accommodation and meals for the Kyorugi, Parataekwondo, Parapoomsae and Poomsae competitions. Arrival: September 23, 2026. Departure: September 28, 2026.
- The Organizing Committee shall pay a daily fee of USD \$150 to the selected International Referees for the competition and training period (total of 5 days; USD \$750,00 per referee, including training and competition days).

11. Head of Team Meeting (Technical Meeting):

The Technical Meeting shall be held on September 23, 2026. Please refer to the general schedule for further details.
