(D) QUALIFICATIONS:

In accordance with Article 4: Qualification of Contestant of the WT Competition Rules, the contestant must meet all the following requirements:

- 1. ELIGIBILITY:** Holder of the nationality of the participating team. An athlete must be nominated by the pertinent national taekwondo association that is recognised by the World Taekwondo.
- 2. DAN CERTIFICATE:** Holder of the Kukkiwon Poom or Dan certificate. (A copy of the Dan certificate should be uploaded to GMS prior registration for event). In case a contestant has applied for a Kukkiwon Dan certificate but has not received it yet, a copy of the Dan application form and the remittance certificate sent to the Kukkiwon must be enclosed when registering for accreditation. Please refer to the Kukkiwon Website (www.kukkiwon.or.kr) for more information.
- 3. WT GLOBAL LICENSE (GAL) & WT COACH CERTIFICATE:** Holder of the WT Global License. For any matters on GAL, including application, please contact: **Miss. Azza Fouly**, GMS Manager, Email: azza.gms@worldtaekwondo.org. Starting from January 1st 2021 WT [Level II] Coach certificate or above is mandatory for officiating at WT promoted like African Senior Championships. If you don't hold Level II coach certificate, please register and participate at any upcoming level I, then Level II coach Courses. Coaches without Level II certificate will not be allowed to coach.
- 4. AGE OF CONTESTANTS:** An athlete must be 17 years old or older in the year of the African Championship. **Athletes who was born in the year of 2003 or before is eligible** to participation in the competition.

(E) COMPETITION DETAILS: WT Competition Rules in force as of the Oct 1, 2020 will be applied

1. METHOD OF COMPETITION:

- a. Single elimination system.
- b. Grade: G4
- c. Seeding and drawing of lots: For every weight category, regardless of number of athletes at 100% of the athletes will be seeded based on WT World Ranking of May 2021 (May 1st)

2. CONTEST TIME:

2 minutes x 3 rounds with 1-minute break.

5. EQUIPMENT:

- a) DAEDO Protector and Scoring System (PSS) will be used at this tournament.
- b) Participating contestants are required to wear Taekwondo uniform and protective equipment as described by the WT regulations.
- c) Body & Head protectors (Protector and Scoring System) will be provided by the OC.
- d) Participating contestants are required to bring their own sensing socks, groin guards, mouthpieces, gloves, and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.

6. WEIGH-IN:

- a) General weigh-in of the contestants shall take place on the day before their respective weight category.
- b) Random weigh-in of the contestants shall take place in the morning on the competition day of their respective weight category except M+87 & W+73. All contestants in draw must be presented.
- c) Random weigh-in selection shall apply with 5% allowance as below table.

- d) During the weigh-in, male contestants shall wear underpants and female contestants shall wear underpants and brassieres. However, contestants may weigh-in in nude if they want.

7. DOPING CONTROL:

- a) The WT Anti-Doping Rules, and where necessary the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competitions.
- b) Random and/or targeted Anti-doping tests will be conducted In Competition. WT and/or WADA may carry out random and/or targeted out-of-competition testing prior, during or after the championships.
- c) TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption)
- d) Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the “Prohibited List” of the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) for therapeutic purposes are requested to visit WT website (<http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/medical-anti-doping/anti-doping/therapeutic-use-exemptions-tues/>) and send their TUE applications to antidoping@worldtaekwondo.org by no later than April 20, 2021.

8. AWARDS:

- a. **INDIVIDUAL AWARDS BY RANK:** Medals will be awarded to the top four athletes in the respective weight divisions.
- i. 1ST PLACE: GOLD MEDAL & CERTIFICATE
 - ii. 2ND PLACE: SILVER MEDAL & CERTIFICATE
 - iii. 3RD PLACE: 2 BRONZE MEDALS & CERTIFICATE
- b. **TEAM AWARDS BY RANK:** Based on the point system below, the top three (3) teams of each of Men's division and Women's division will receive trophies.

For every win (including byes):	1
For every Gold Medal:	120
For every Silver Medal:	50
For every Bronze Medal:	20

(F) TECHNICAL DETAILS:

1. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS (Details Cover: Africa Senior Kyrougi & Team Championships):

Technical Officials such, Competition Supervisory Board and International referees will be appointed by WTAF, while the Technical Delegate will be appointed by the WT.

a) **TECHNICAL DELEGATE:**

- One (1) Technical Delegate will be appointed to oversee the tournament and make decisions on technical matters.
- The Organizing Committee shall pay for the expenses of room and board for the Technical Delegate for (5) nights' stay; Check-in on May 19 and Check-out on May 24.

b) **SUPERVISORY BOARD:**

- Five (5) Competition Supervisory Board members (including Technical Delegate) will be appointed.
- The Organizing Committee shall pay for the expenses of room and board for Competition Supervisory Board members for (6) nights' stay; Check-in on May 19 and Check-out on May 24.

c) **INTERNATIONAL REFEREES:**

- Thirty-Six (36) International Referees, including Review Jury, will be appointed to officiate at the tournament.
- The Organizing Committee shall pay for the expenses of room and board for International Referees for (5) nights' stay; Check-in on May 19 and Check-out on May 24. The Organizing Committee shall pay a per diem of US\$100 to the selected Technical Officials during competition period (for competition days).

2. HEAD OF TEAM MEETING & DRAWING OF LOTS SESSION:

The head of team meeting and the drawing of lots session shall be conducted two (2) days prior to the start of the championships that is May 20th, 2021, in the presence of the WT/WTAF officials and the representatives of the participating nations.

3. COACH ATTIRE:

All coaches are required to wear formal suit such as tie, jacket, dress shirt (long or short), and trouser from semi-final matches. If any coach refuses to wear abovementioned attire, he or she won't be allowing to coach.

4. INDEMNITIES:

- a) The respective national taekwondo associations shall be responsible for ensuring that all officials and participants are covered with effective travel & medical insurance.
- b) Participants without proper insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete at the championships.
- c) The Organizing Committee will acquire general Public Liability event insurance.

5. NATIONAL FLAG AND ANTHEM:

Every participating national taekwondo association is required to bring the following items for use at the Opening, Closing and Awarding ceremonies, and submit them to the Organizing Committee during registration.

- Two (2) IOC-recognized national flags with the size of 90cm x 130cm
- CD or DVD of the pertinent IOC-recognized national anthem

(G) ACCOMMODATION AND LOGISTICS:

3. REGISTRATION & ENTRY FEES:

- a. The OC shall collect the entry fees from the participating national teams. The national team shall pay an entry fee to the OC at the time of registration at the accreditation center(s) prior to the start of the Championships. Athletes shall not be allowed to compete without successful payment of entry fee.
- b. Entry fee shall be various according to the timing and situation of the submission of entry. Please read carefully the following guidelines:

DISCOUNTED REGISTRATION FEES:

A discount will be given to national teams that complete their registration during this period.

- \$ 100 USD per athlete
- Discounted entry fee period will begin on **April 1st** and will end on **April 15th, 2021**.

REGULAR ENTRY FEES:

- \$ 125 USD per athlete.
- Regular entry fee period will begin on **April 16th**, and will end on **May 1st, 2021**.

LATE REGISTRATION FEES:

- \$150 per athlete.
- Late registration fee period would begin on **May 1st**, and will end on **May 10th, 2021**.
