# 2. DATE AND PLACE

DATE:	15-16th of September 2018

# 3. CONTESTANTS

CATEGORIES:	Seniors Male and Female, Juniors Male and Female, Cadets Male and Female.
AGE:	Cadets born in 2006, 2005 and 2004 Juniors born in 2003, 2002, 2001 Seniors born in 2001 and older <u>An athlete who was born in 2001 can compete as a junior or as a senior. Competing in both categories is not allowed.</u>
GRADUATION:	All senior and junior competitors must hold at least 2nd Geup, cadets must hold at least 4th Geup.
WEIGHT DIVISIONS:	WT-classes.
QUALIFICATIONS:	Participants must be members of a National Taekwondo Federation, affiliated to the WT. An approved 2018 WT Global License (WT Global Athlete License OR Global Official License) is required by all athletes and officials who wish to register for the 25th Polish Open - 21st Warsaw Cup Taekwondo Championships. WT Global License registrations & renewals can only be made through the WT recognized Member National Associations and application should be made at least 2 months before the Tournament starts to ensure the WT license can be processed and approved in time. There will be NO WT Global License registration onsite. Entry fees are obligated at all times.



## 4. RULES

### COMPETITION RULES:

WT Competition rules with Electronic Body Protector, E-Head Gear, Instant Video Replay, 2 quotas until and including semi-final 1 bonus quota will be given in final when all quotas have been used.

### SEEDING:

Seeding of Senior Athletes will be based on the Sep 2018 Rankings (including events until end of August 2018).

### MODE:

Single elimination tournament system. Seniors: elimination rounds and finals: 3 x 2 minutes (30 sec break) or 3 x 1,5 minutes. Juniors and Cadets: elimination rounds and finals: 3 x 1,5 minutes (30 sec break). The organization committee and WT Technical Delegate can decide to adjust the competition.

### DOPING CONTROL:

A few contestants chosen at random will be tested.

### AWARDS:

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and two 3<sup>rd</sup> places will be awarded.

### HALL RULES:

Only the competitors and their coaches will have admittance with valid accreditations to the contest areas.

### EQUIPMENT:

WT-recognized PSS Daedo Gen 2 + E-helmet shall be provided for all competition areas and all weight divisions (cadet, junior and senior). Only WT-recognized Equipment groin-, forearm-, shin-, mouthpiece and gloves will be brought by the contestants, which is compulsory. Sensor socks will not be provided by the organization team and must be purchased by each competitor.

### PROTEST:

Only the official coach is allowed, to protest to the LSC, immediately after the end of the contest. An amount of €100 will have to be paid for each protest. The protest amount will not be refunded in any case.

### LIABILITY:

All competitors are considered to participate at their own risk. Polish Taekwondo Federation and the organizer assume no responsibility for any damages, injuries or losses, and specifically note that they also take no responsibility for any damages, losses, injuries or other consequences due to (directly or indirectly) acts of terrorism or terrorist threats. All contestants must bring their own documents and forms for any medical treatment in Poland. If not, this will have to be paid in cash. By registering, Club takes responsibility for application form in accordance with real data and with the consent of legal guardians (underage players), and accepts the competition rules.

### IDENTIFICATION:

According to Polish law all competitors and visitors need to have a valid Identification by means of a valid passport or other official identification document

## 5. ENTRY

### REGISTRATION:

Registration is only accepted through the WT Event Registration system <https://worldtkd.simplycompete.com/> and registration is only possible with a valid 2018 WT Global License.

*The following documents are required for all participants to be uploaded and approved by the National Federation and WT before you are able to register your team through the WT Event Registration System.*

*For ALL participants (athletes and officials):*

- 1. Valid National ID or Passport of the National Federations you are registering for a WT Global License.*
- 2. WT Signed Event Liability Waiver (page 3 only) – valid for 5 years.*
- 3. Colour Portrait ID picture.*
- 4. To register a Doctor – Proof of Medical Doctor/Physio therapist certificate in English*

### DEADLINE:

31<sup>st</sup> of August at 11:59 p.m. Warsaw time, or after reaching 450 competitors (senior categories) and 800 (junior and cadets categories).

### ACCREDITATIONS:

Extra coach passes can be requested including WT GMS number separately for €25,00 euro for each individual coach. Please note that only 1 competitor and 1 coach can enter the competition area. National teams are allowed to have following accreditations: 2 Officials, 1 official doctor (not second coach), 1 coach. Club teams can only register coach accreditations. All other accreditations are not allowed. One (1) coach for every five (5) competitors has free admission with a maximum of six (6) coaches per team. The minimum age for a coach must be 18 years.

### MODIFICATIONS:

Modifications are possible at the registration for an amount of €25,00 for each modification (only weight changes), after the official weigh-in no further modifications will be made. This means no changes will be made in weight divisions!

### IMPORTANT:

If the athlete registered on-line does not take part in the competition, and he/she has not been replaced by another participant before the date 31<sup>st</sup> of August his/her team or official must fully (100%) pay his/her entry fee for participation. Entry fee is not refundable at any time after the deadline!

### VISA:

If you need a Visa for Poland, you can send official request for assistance with filled in visa application form (available on website [www.warsawcup.com](http://www.warsawcup.com)) to: [warsawcup@wp.pl](mailto:warsawcup@wp.pl). It is advised to arrange the VISA in time. Deadline for Visa assistance is July 31<sup>st</sup>.



#### ENTRY FEE & PAYMENT:

€ 75,00 (Euro) for each contestant.

Application is only valid when payment has been done at the same time of Registrations through our bank account. Applications are only valid when payments of all entry fees have been received within 5 days. If payment is not received within 5 days the application will be removed from the online registration. Entries done 5 days before the deadline must be paid immediately. All fees must be paid in EUROS and please ensure you pay any additional currency charges.
