- Holder of Taekwondo Dan(Poom) certificate issued by the Kukkiwon

5. METHODS OF COMPETITION

- The best of three (3) system
- Men's / Women's : (Respectively) Single elimination tournament system for each weight category.
- Each match allows for one video replay request
- All competitors must wear WT-approved competition uniform and protective equipment.
- Senior division seeded according to the published July 1st 2026 World Taekwondo rankings.
30% of contestants shall be seeded.

(Changed during Head of team meeting at the discretion of the TD.)

- **KPNP(K2)** Protector and Scoring System (PSS) will be used in Kyorugi competition.
The Organizing Committee will provide **KPNP(K2)** Protector and Scoring System (PSS) to the participating contestants. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthpieces, gloves, sensing socks and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.

6. COMPETITION RULES

- Latest WT Competition Rules shall be applied.

7. DURATION OF COMPETITION

- Senior: 2 minutes x 3 rounds (1 minute break time)

8. WEIGH-IN

- General Weigh-in for the contestants shall be completed one day before their scheduled competition day.
- Weigh-in shall be made once, however, in case of under or exceeding, one more chance will be given within the weigh-in time. (approximately two hours)
- All contestants should bring their AD cards when they weigh-in, otherwise disqualification.
- The random weigh-in will take place at the venue in the morning of the competition. All contestants who pass the general weigh-in must be present for random weigh-in maximum two (2) hours before the start of the competition. Should a contestant fail to appear for the random weigh-in, he/she will be disqualified. The random weigh-in must be completed maximum thirty (30) minutes before the start of the competition each day.
- The list of athletes selected for the random weigh-in will be announced on the O.C Website on the morning of the competition day.
- It may be subject to change at the discretion of the TD during the head of team meeting.

9. OTHERS

- Matters not specified in the regulation shall be decided after deliberation by the Organizing Committee of Chuncheon Leisure-Taekwondo.
- All officials including Head and coaches of each team must complete the registration as officials and hold an AD card to enter the stadium. And must have completed WT Coach Certification Course LV1.
- If the competitor is called 3 times 30 minutes before the start of the game and do not participate after declaring the participation, the competitor will be disqualified.
- In cases of clear system errors(such as changes in participant categories or missing participants), the athlete will be added to the last match number of their category
- It may be subject to change at the discretion of the TD during the head of team meeting.

2. QUALIFICATIONS

- Holder of Taekwondo Dan certificate issued by Kukkiwon.
- Recognized Poomsae : Competitor who participates in the **individual categories UNDER 30 (Senior I) and UNDER 40 (Senior II)** should be registered on the GMS. (Global Membership System)
- Free Style Poomsae : Competitor who participates in the **Individual, Pair and Mixed Team divisions of OVER 17 (18 years old or older)** should be registered on the GMS. (Global Memberships System)

3. COMPETITIONS (Men's & Women's)

- A. Recognized Poomsae(Senior)
 - 1) Senior I : Born 1996 – 2008 (18 – 30 years old)
 - 2) Senior II : Born 1986 – 1995 (31 – 40 years old)
- B. Free Style Poomsae : Born in 2008 or before (18 years old or older)

4. DURATION OF CONTEST

- A. Recognized Poomsae : up to 90 seconds
- B. Free Style Poomsae : 90 seconds to 100 seconds

※ Break time : within 30sec to 60sec / Exceeding the time, deduction shall be applied.

1) Methods Of Competition

- Single elimination tournament System shall be applied to the Recognized Poomsae Competition.
- In case of an insufficient number of Competitors in each category, a demonstration shall be carried out.
- Competitors should be wearing WT-recognized Poomsae uniform(Dobok).
- Seeds will be assigned, but the ratio will be determined by the TD during the head of team meeting.

2) The competition area for Recognized Poomsae : 10m×10m

3) Scoring of Recognized Poomsae

- Poomsae(Individual)
 - Composition of refereeing official shall be a five-judge system.
 - Final score shall be the average point of the total points summed up except the highest and lowest points scored by 5 judges.
 - In case of a tied score, the winner shall be the one who has scored higher points in order of Presentation, and total points(total points of all judges including highest and lowest points).
 - If it is still tied in Presentation, and total points, then a rematch shall be conducted to determine the winner.
 - In case of a tied score after the rematch, the winner shall be the contestant who is awarded more points in total, including the highest and lowest scores that were not included in collection of scores.

4) Designation of Recognized Poomsae and the drawing of lots

- Two (2) Poomsae from the designated Compulsory Poomsae decided by Technical Delegate for each division must be performed for all the preliminary, semi final and final rounds for all competitions.

※ The regulation articles above are subject to change in the Head of Team meeting.

1) Methods Of Competition

- Cut-off System shall be applied to the Free Style Poomsae Competition.
- Free Style Poomsae is the performance based on Taekwondo techniques with composition of music and choreography.
- Composition of Free Style Poomsae
 - Yeon-mu line shall choice of contestant.
 - Music and choreography shall be the choice of contestants.
 - Performed techniques must be within boundary of Taekwondo. The definition of Taekwondo techniques shall be determined by WT Poomsae Committee, when contestant submits performance plan.
- Competitors should be wearing WT-recognized Poomsae uniform(Dobok).
- Seeds will be assigned, but the ratio will be determined by the TD during the head of team meeting.

2) The competition area for Free Style Poomsae

- Individual & Pair 10m × 10m
- Mixed Team 12m x 12m

3) Scoring of Free Style Poomsae

- Allotted Scoring Chart for Free Style Poomsae : WT Poomsae scoring criteria and procedures shall be applied.

※ Freestyle music should be submitted at the Competition Headquarters by July 21, 17:00 on a USB with the following details. (On the USB, each digital file should contain)

- Name of the country
- Name of the category
- Name of the athlete / athletes

※ The USB itself should be marked with the name of the country and should be submitted in an envelope or a bag, with a list of contents of the USB in the same way as described above. Please see the attached picture below.

※ All music should be submitted in USB (CD is not acceptable) and will be returned.



※ Note : Music in USB (Music without lyrics) and choreography shall be choice of a contestant, it should NOT contain any political, social, and religious and any contents that may harm, discriminate or offend other.

7. OTHERS

- The regulation articles above are subject to change in the Head of Team meeting.
- All officials including Head and coaches of each team must complete the registration as officials and hold an AD card to enter the stadium. And All Poomsae Coaches participating in WT recognized/promoted competitions must hold the valid WT Poomsae Coach Certificate.
- If the competitor is called 3 times 30 minutes before the start of the game and do not participate after declaring the participation, the competitor will be disqualified.
- Matters not specified in the regulation shall be decided after deliberation by the Organizing Committee of Chuncheon Leisure·Taekwondo.
- In cases of clear system errors(such as changes in participant categories or missing participants), the athlete will be added to the last match number of their category.

※ If there is a tie,

- The athlete who has participated in the most matches will be prioritized.
 - Unproceeded matches(Opponents’ disqualification during the weigh-in, abstention match due to submission of a memorandum of abandonment) are not counted.
- If the above is still tied: the athlete of a weight class who participated in the most games is prioritized.
- If the above is still tied: the athlete with the most points will be prioritized.
- If the above is still tied: the athlete with the fewer lost points will be prioritized.
- If the above is still no decision: The competition management team will make the final decision.

– Team Awards

- “Gold”takes priority over “Silver”, and “Silver” takes priority over “Bronze”.
- If there is a tie, the team with the most medals in the most games will be prioritized.
- Overall competition awards will only be given to teams that participate in 4 or more weight classes.
- For cases of failure to weigh-in or disqualification due to weight-related issues, the team’s composition and the total number of participants will be excluded from the final count.
- If the above is still a tie, the team with the most athletes advancing to the Top 8 or Top 16 will be prioritized, but still tied then the ranking will be determined by weight class.

2. INDEMNITY

- A. Organizing Committee effects accident insurance for all competitors during the competition only.
- B. Only first-aid treatment is available for wounds from the competition.

3. PARTICIPATION SUPPORT

- GROUND TRANSPORTATION : The O.C. will provide ground transportation between Incheon airport and Chuncheon.

※ A detailed schedule will be announced in due course.

※ The O.C. will also provide shuttle bus between accommodations and venue during the Championships.

※ Except for those who participating through other travel agencies or regions.

- Round trip airfare and accommodation expenses(room and board) shall be the sole responsibility of the participants.

4. NOTICE

- The decision of the Review Referee is final; no further appeals during the contest or protest after the contest will be accepted.
- Details not specified in this outline can be modified or added at the Head of Team Meeting.
