4. DATE OF CHAMPIONSHIPS: June 16th – 18th, 2021

## 5. QUALIFICATIONS:

**a.** In accordance with Article 4: Qualification of Contestant of the WT Competition Rules, the contestant must be:

**Criterion** #1: Holder of the nationality of the participating team.

Criterion #2: One recommended by the WT National Taekwondo Association.

**Criterion** #3: Holder of Taekwondo Dan certificate issued by the Kukkiwon.

**Criterion** #4: Holder of the WT Global Athlete License (GAL).

Criterion #5: The age limits are based on the year 2021, not on the date. Kyorugi (17

years old or older) contestants in the year of the 2021.

Athletes born before December 31st, 2004 are eligible.

**b.** Coaches must <u>hold the WT Coach Certification Level II</u> (granted by participation in WT Coach Certification Course)









### 6. COMPETITION RULES

- a. The WT Competition Rules and Interpretation (In force as of October 1st, 2020).
- b. The WT Athlete Classification Rules shall be applied.

## 7. METHOD OF COMPETITION FOR KYORUGI: Single elimination system

- Contest Time: 2 minutes, 3 rounds with 1 minute break in between rounds.
- The number of Court: 3 courts

### 8. CLASSIFICATIONS AND DIVISIONS FOR KYORUGI:

Maximum entry: 6 male and 6 female athletes, one per weight category.

- ➤ According to the WT official letter (July 12, 2017) sent to Member National Associations (MNAs) in Continent of Asia, the followings will be applied to the championships.
  - All medalists from WT President's Cup-Asian Region are qualified directly for <u>next</u> <u>Asian Senior, Junior, and Cadet Championships.</u> (Only 1 athlete per each weight category from each MNA can qualify for the abovementioned Asian Championships via the 3<sup>rd</sup> WT President's Cup-Asian Region.)

# Extra Quotas from WT President's Cup-Asia Region









- 1) An athlete who wins a medal from the 3<sup>rd</sup> WT President's Cup-Asia Region held in Iran in 2019 must submit their application form individually. Please do not include them in their team of MNA and the athletes must register in the same weight category that they participated in the 3<sup>rd</sup> WT President's Cup-Asia Region with the result.
- 2) Participating athletes through extra quota by winning a medal from the 3<sup>rd</sup> WT President's Cup-Asian Region will participate in the 2021 Asian Taekwondo Championships individually and their ranks can be recognized at the Championships, but their points will not be included in their MNA for the team awards.
  - ★ Seeding will be decided at the Head of Team Meeting.

## 9. CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATING TEAMS

**a.** Round-trip airfare and accommodation charges of room and board shall be borne by the participating National Association.

## b. Entry Fees:

- Kyorugi: US\$ 100 per Athlete

The OC shall collect the entry fees from the participating national teams. The national team shall pay an entry fee to the OC in cash in US dollar at the accreditation center in Beirut prior to the start of the Championships. Athletes shall not be allowed to compete without successful payment of entry fees to the OC.

- ➤ Entry deadline is **May 31**st, **2021** local time in Beirut and entry will be only accepted via online registration at <a href="https://worldtkd.simplycompete.com">https://worldtkd.simplycompete.com</a>
- ➤ Entry submission after May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021 local time in Beirut will be not accepted under any circumstances.
- ➤ Entry fee of US\$ 100 per athlete (Kyorugi) will not be charged in case of cancellation of participation until May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021 local time in Beirut. Entry fee must be paid in case of the notice of cancellation of participating athletes or no show after May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2021 local time in Beirut, Lebanon.

A corresponding amount will be charged accordingly by the OC at the accreditation center in Beirut if any team official who is not registered online wants to be accredited at the accreditation center Beirut. This shall apply even the total number of team officials do not exceed the designated number.









## c. Ground transportation:

Ground transportation will be provided for National Teams on arrival and departure, provided that the OC has been informed of the date, time, and flight number of the National Team's arrival and departure <u>no later than May 31st</u>, 2021. The OC will also provide ground transportation to and from all official hotels, training venue and the competition venue, provided that the National Teams stay at the host hotels.

**d.** The participating teams are required to submit the hotel reservation to Organizing Committee no later than **May 31**st, **2021.**

### 11. CLASSIFICATION OF RESULTS

- Individual Awards: medals will be awarded to the top four athletes in the respective weight categories of the pertinent championships:

1st Place	Gold Medal and Certificate
2 <sup>nd</sup> Place	Silver Medal and Certificate
3 <sup>rd</sup> Place	Bronze Medal and Certificate
3 <sup>rd</sup> Place	Bronze Medal and Certificate

According to the Bylaw of WT World Ranking, the athletes who advance to round of 16 or above will get ranking points. The points will be reflected in WT World Ranking.

\*\* There will not be any point award given to athletes registered as medalist from WT President's Cup.









- Team Awards: based on the point system below, the top three (3) teams of the Men's division and the top three (3) teams of the Women's division will receive trophies.

Best Referees: Three (3) trophies will be awarded to the best referees.

Best Coaches: Three (3) trophies will be awarded to the best coaches.

Best Athletes: Two (2) trophies will be awarded to the best male and female

athletes.

Other Prize: The 'Good Fighting Spirit Prize' may be awarded to selected athlete.

## - Dress Code for Medalists:

All medalists should be dressed as follows during the awards ceremony.

- ▶ Dobok or Training suits
- ▶ Sneakers or Taekwondo shoes

Medal ceremony will take place IMMEDIATELY after the end of the final match of each category.

### 12. INTERNATIONAL REFEREES

WT Asia will appoint at least 45 International Referees (IR) including 2 Referee-Chairmen. The appointed IRs shall officiate at the 6th Asian Para Taekwondo Open Championships, 24th Asian Taekwondo Championships, 6th Asian Taekwondo Poomsae Championships and the following conditions shall apply.

- IRs are required to pay for their own round-trip airfares.
- The OC shall provide free accommodation, meals and transportation (Check-in: June 12<sup>th</sup> and Check-out: June 19<sup>th</sup>, 2021).
- The OC shall also pay a per diem of US \$100 to IRs for each competition day.

#### 13. DRESS CODE FOR COACHES









- Coaches must be appropriately attired in sportswear while accompanying their athletes. For semi-finals and finals, coaches are to wear formal jacket. Coaches who do not follow the dress code will not be allowed to enter the field of play.

## 14. WT-RECOGNIZED TAEKWONDO UNIFORM (DOBOK) AND PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- Daedo Protector and Scoring System (PSS) Gen 2 will be used in Kyorugi competition.
- Participating contestants are required to wear only WT-approved competition Uniform (Dobok) and protective equipment. The latest version of WT recognized manufacturers' list is available at the website of World Taekwondo.
- The OC will provide Daedo trunk PSS, head PSS and related items and equipment to the participating contestants, while contestants are required to bring their own groin, forearm and shin guards, mouth guards, hand protector, sensing sock Daedo Gen 2 for their personal use (It can also be purchased from Daedo shop at the venue if needed).

#### 15. SPONSOR'S IDENTIFICATION

- ONE sponsor's identification(logo) is allowed to each of Kyorugi uniform's top and bottoms.
- The sponsor's identification shall be located within 50m² except the location of WT logo, manufacturer's identification, national flag, and NOC code.
- The detailed Application Guidelines of Sponsor's Identification is available at the WT website at (http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/wp-content/uploads/2018/05/Final\_Kyorugi-Uniform-Sponsorship\_v7.pdf).

#### **16. MEDICAL CONTROL**

- For all 2021 WT Asia Taekwondo events, any use or administration of drugs or chemical substance described in the WT Anti-Doping Rules is prohibited. The WADA Anti-Doping Code shall be applied to these competitions.
- The OC shall be responsible for making all necessary preparations for conducting doping tests. The details of the WT Anti-Doping Rules shall be enacted as part of the bylaws.

#### 17. TEAM DOCTOR ACCREDITATION

- At the time of submission of entry for team officials, copies of relevant and appropriate licenses of team doctor or physiotherapist written in English shall be attached. After verification, special accreditation cards shall be issued to the team doctors and









physiotherapists. Only those who have obtained proper accreditation shall be allowed to proceed to the competition area with the coach.

#### 18. HEAD OF TEAM MEETING & DRAWING OF LOTS

- The Head of Team Meeting and Drawing of lots shall be conducted on **June 13**th, **2021** for Poomsae and Kyorugi competitions.
- At the end of the designated registration date, the OC shall announce the list of registered contestants in each weight category on the official website of the OC/WT Asia. Participating teams are responsible to confirming their entries before the drawing of lots.
- The drawing of lots shall be conducted by random computerized drawing.
- A certain number of contestants shall be seeded based on the WT Ranking.

#### 19. WEIGH-IN

- General weigh-in of the contestants on the day of competition shall be organized one day prior to the competition.
- The random weigh-in will take place at the venue in the morning of the competition. All contestants who pass the general weigh-in must be present for random weigh-in maximum two (2) hours before the start of the competition.
  - Should a contestant fail to appear for the random weigh-in, he/she will be disqualified. The random weigh-in must be completed maximum thirty (30) minutes before the start of the competition each day.
- During the weigh-in, male contestants shall wear underpants and female contestants shall wear underpants and brassieres. However, contestants may weigh-in the nude if they want to do so.

## **20. INDEMNITIES**

- The respective Member National Associations shall be responsible for ensuring that their participants have validly completed and signed the official participation forms, thus indemnifying the organizers and its officials and/or staff/ volunteers, WT, WT Asia and/or its officials/ staff, any Technical Officials and other contestants of the Championships from any claims of injuries, losses, fatalities or otherwise arising in the course of participation in these championships or any activities thereto.
- The respective Member National Associations shall be responsible for ensuring that all









officials and participants are covered with effective insurance coverage.

- Participants without proper participation entry forms and effective insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete at the championships.

## 21. NATIONAL FLAG AND ANTHEM

- Every participating MNAs are required to bring along the following items for use at the Opening and/or Closing ceremonies:
  - + Two (2) IOC-recognized national flags, Size: 90cm x 130cm
  - + USB or (CD/DVD) of the pertinent IOC-recognized national anthem

### 27. VISA/ACCOMMODATION/LOCAL TRANSPORTATION:

- All matters pertaining to hotel booking, visa and ground transportation should be filled directly through GMS. Please fill out the relevant forms:
  - Visa form is attached.
  - Accommodation/Transportation Form is attached.
- Participating teams are requested to fill out the "Accommodation/Transportation Form" completely so that the OC can arrange local transportation. Local transportation may not be provided by the OC for the teams that do not send this form.
- National teams with NO confirmed booking in the official hotel via Organizing Committee will not be able to participate due to Covid-19 restrictions and overall safety.
- All teams participating at the event shall mandatorily book their hotel accommodation via the Organizing Committee Any athlete or mixed team members that do not comply with this regulation will not be able to participate at the event.

#### 28. ATHLETE REPLACEMENT

In the event that the registered athletes should be replaced by another due to injuries, the Member National Association can officially request to the WT Asia for the replacement by no later than **May 31**st, **2021** by submitting 'Late athlete replacement form' together with certification from the medical doctor in the language of the pertinent country and also in English to <a href="mailto:admin@wtasia.org">admin@wtasia.org</a> with attention to WT Asia Secretary General. The decision on the acceptance will be made after evaluation of the submitted documents.
