
It is our great pleasure to extend an official invitation to your association to participate in these prestigious events.

Qualifications	: In accordance with Article 4 of the WT Para Taekwondo Competition Rules, the contestant must be: <u>Criterion #1</u> Holder of the nationality of the participating team. Athletes with a refugee status issued by either governmental authorities in the country of residence or the UNHCR may be entered into tournaments and championships under WT flag based on prior approval from WT. <u>Criterion #2</u> An athlete recommended by a WT recognized Member National Association (MNA). <u>Criterion #3</u> Holder of a Para Taekwondo Dan issued by the WT / Kukkiwon or a MNA recognised 5-1 Geup. <u>Criterion #4</u> Holder of a valid 2019 WT Global Athlete License (GAL). Please contact your assigned WT GMS Manager for any questions. <u>Criterion #5</u> Contestant shall be at least 16 years old in the year of the 2019 Asian Para Taekwondo Open Championships. (Born on or before 31 December 2003) <u>Criterion #6</u>

	<p>Athlete must go through International Classification in accordance with the WT Athlete Classification Rules and be assigned a Sport Class and Sport Class Status prior to the tournament.</p> <p>Athletes found Not Eligible (NE) will NOT be able to compete.</p>																		
Events	<p>: <u>Kyorugi K40 Sport Classes</u></p> <p>The Para Taekwondo Kyorugi K40 Classes (K41, K42, K3 & K44) are for athletes with a physical impairment. Kyorugi Rules	<p>: The of the most updated version of the WT Para Taekwondo Competition Rules will be implemented for the Para Taekwondo competitions of the K40 Sport Classes at the 2019 Asian Para Taekwondo Open Championships.</p> <p>Please note that Article 10.5 of the WT Para Taekwondo Competition Rules will be in effect. Athletes that fail weigh-in shall be DISQUALIFIED. All athletes are required to be registered in the correct weight division by the end of the registration deadline. WEIGHT DIVISION WILL NOT BE CHANGED IN THE CASE THE ATHLETE DOES NOT PASS THE WEIGH-IN.</p>																		
PSS	<p>: KPNP Protective and Scoring System (PSS) and hit-levels will be used at the 2019 Asian Para Taekwondo Open Championships.</p>

<p>Global Athlete License & Online Registration</p>	<p>: <u>WT Global License Registration</u></p> <p>All Team Officials and athletes must FIRST be registered with a valid 2019 WT License. You will not be able to register without renewing the license for 2019.</p> <p><u>WT Online Registration</u></p> <p>National Team Entry will only be accepted through the WT online registration system and registration is only possible with a valid WT Global Licence. National Team GMS administrators will be notified via email once online registration is open.</p>
<p>Entry Fees</p>	<p>: The Organizing Committee (OC) shall collect the entry fees from the participating national teams. The national team shall pay an entry fee to the OC by cash in USD 50 per athlete, at the accreditation center in Amman, Jordan, prior to the start of the Championships. Athletes shall not be allowed to compete without successful payment of entry fee to the OC.</p> <p>Registrations will close on June 30th, 2019.</p>
<p>International Classification</p>	<p>: Kyorugi (K40)</p> <p>The International Classification of all Kyorugi (K40 Sport Classes) athletes will take place on 17 July 2019. A schedule for International Classification for all teams and athletes will be set up by the WT (Asian)/OC and communicated to all teams following the close of registration on July 2nd, 2019. All teams should prepare their travel for their athletes to be available for International Classification on 17 July 2019.</p> <p><u>Medical Diagnostics From through World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS)</u></p> <p>Following IPC Guidelines on data protection concerning athletes and personal classification information. World Taekwondo has in connection with IPC created the World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS). World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS) is our new online registration tool for MNAs to register their new athletes and add Medical Diagnostic Forms (MDF) and pictures to be seen by our Classification Evaluation Committee in order to determine if the new athlete is eligible for Para Taekwondo and meets Minimum Impairment Criteria (MIC). <p>Combination of Classes and Divisions</p>	<p>: WT (Asia) reserves the right to combine Sport classes in the case of insufficient participation. Combination of Sport classes will be made by the Technical Delegate in consultation with the WT Head of Classification in accordance with the WT Para Taekwondo Competition Rules.</p> <p>Kyorugi Classes will be combines as follows.</p> <p>K41 > K42 K42 > K43 K43 > K44</p> <p><u>Important</u> Consolidated athletes will be awarded the gold medal in the Sport Class and weight division where they are consolidated and will have the chance to compete for medals in the Sport Class they are consolidated into.</p>						
<p>Method of Competition</p>	<p>: <u>Kyorugi</u> The competition in the K40 Sport Classes at the 2019 Asian Para Taekwondo Open Championships will be held in single elimination tournament system.</p> <p>The duration of contest shall be three (3) rounds of two (2) minutes each with a one (1) minute rest period between rounds. In the case of a tied score after the completion of the third (3rd) round, a fourth (4th) round of two (2) minutes will be conducted as the Gold Round, after a one (1) minute rest period following the third (3rd) round.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The duration of contest may be adjusted to one (1) minute x 3 rounds, one (1) minute 30 seconds x three (3) rounds with a 30 second to one (1) minute break between rounds upon the decision of the Technical Delegate. - 						
<p>Conditions of Participation</p>	<p>: Round trip airfare and accommodation, charges of room and board shall be borne by the participating MNA.</p> <p>The OC shall collect the entry fees from the participating national teams. The national team shall pay an entry fee to the OC in cash USD 50 per athlete only at the accreditation center in Amman, Jordan prior to the start of the Championships. Athletes shall not be allowed to compete without successful payment of entry fee to the OC.</p> <p>Entry will only be accepted through the WT online registration system – WT GMS.</p>
