3. QUALIFICATION

- All athletes and coaches must hold a valid 2022 WT athlete and Global license to be able to participate in the Senegal OPEN. Participants must be member of a National Taekwondo Federation, affiliated to the WT¹. All clubs are committed themselves to obtain from their athletes & coach a Global License.
- Participants must be holder of Kukkiwon Poom or Dan certificate (a copy of the Dan certificate should be uploaded to GMS prior registration for event). In case a contestant has applied for a Kukkiwon Dan certificate but has not received it yet, a copy of the Dan application form and the remittance certificate sent to the Kukkiwon must be enclosed when registering for accreditation. Please refer to the Kukkiwon Website (www.kukkiwon.or.kr) for more information.
- Seniors (Male and Female) must be 17 year or older² (year of Birth: 2005 and older).
- Starting from January 1st 2021 WT [Level I] Coach certificate is mandatory for officiating at WT promoted like G2 ranked tournament. If you don't hold Level I coach certificate, please register, and participate at any upcoming level I coach Courses. Coaches without Level I certificate will not be allowed to coach during the Senegal Open.

4. GLOBAL INFORMATION COVID19 RESTRICTION

- For all travelers to Senegal, the presence of the complete vaccination card with QR is required;
- A NEGATIVE RT-PCR test not exceeding 72 hours is required for all incoming travelers who are not or incompletely vaccinated;

- A PCR test or the presence of the complete vaccination card with QR is required for children from 2 years old to enter Senegal;
- Epidemiological control is reinforced at border entry points;
- Green paper passes are no longer accepted).



Objet : Adaptation des stratégies et mesures de riposte contre la COVID-19 au Sénégal

Depuis deux ans, le Sénégal fait face à la pandémie COVID-19 qui évolue par vagues associées à des variants de contagiosité et de gravité différentes.

Depuis plusieurs semaines, la situation épidémiologique est marquée par une baisse du cumul hebdomadaire de cas confirmés par test RT-PCR, des cas graves admis dans les centres de traitement épidémique (CTE) ainsi que les décès liés à la Covid -19.

En conséquence, les mesures suivantes sont adoptées :

- Par tous les voyageurs à destination du Sénégal, la présentation de la carte de vaccination complète avec QR est exigée ;
- Le test RT-PCR NEGATIF n'excédant pas 72 heures est demandé à tout voyageur entrant, non ou incomplètement vacciné ;
- La surveillance épidémiologique est renforcée au niveau des points d'entrée frontaliers.

Les voyageurs sortant du Sénégal devront se conformer aux mesures réglementaires de leur pays de destination.

5. VISA & ENTRY CONDITION IN SENEGAL

- **Visa-exempt foreign nationals** : All European Union citizens, Algeria, Andorra, Argentina, Australia, Bahamas, Bahrain, Barbados, Benin, Botswana, Brazil, Brunei, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cameroon, Canada, Cape Verde, Central African Republic, Chad, Comoros, Congo, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Costa Rica, Côte d'Ivoire, Egypt, El Salvador, Ethiopia, Fiji, Gabon, Gambia, Ghana, Grenada, Guatemala, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Haiti, Honduras, Iceland, India, Israel, Jamaica, Japan, Kenya, Kiribati, Kosovo, Kuwait, Lesotho, Liberia, Liechtenstein, Madagascar, Malawi, Malaysia, Mali, Marshall Islands, Mauritania, Mauritius, Micronesia, Monaco, Morocco, Namibia, Nepal, New Zealand, Niger, Nigeria, Norway, Oman, Russia, Rwanda, Saint Kitts and Nevis, Saint Lucia, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Samoa, San Marino, Seychelles, Sierra Leone, Singapore, Solomon Islands, South Africa, South Korea, Sri Lanka, Suriname, Swaziland, Switzerland, Thailand, Timor Leste, Togo, Tunisia, Turkey, Tuvalu, Uganda, Ukraine, United Arab Emirates, United States, Vanuatu, Vatican City, Zambia, Zimbabwe.
- **Nationalities subject to visa and eligible for e-Visa online:** citizens of all other nationalities can obtain their visa online (e-Visa) or in embassies.
- **E-Visa online procedure:** Senegal has established since 2013 the obligation to obtain a biometric visa for travelers of nationalities who were hitherto exempted. The visa procedure is quite complicated and happens in two stages. At first, the payment of the visa (50€) and of the cost of delivery shall be made on the dedicated website (www.visaseneal.sn). A number of information must be provided at this time online.
- Once this step is complete, a visit to a diplomatic representation equipped to issue biometric visas is required. You will undergo a strict control of all documents, as well as a taking of a digital photo and a fingerprinting of all fingers. A special procedure for taking fingerprints of 10 toes is provided for disabled passengers no longer having fingers in particular for our bi-national leper compatriots residing abroad but having no more Senegalese documents.
- Depending on consulates and peak periods, formalities can be long. So you will need a full day to get your visa. Accordingly, it is recommended that travelers look in detail what papers and documents are required for the visa, especially if you live hundreds of miles far from a Senegalese diplomatic representation. As an exception, any passenger subject to the visa in Senegal, who for various reasons is not able to pre-enroll or to join an embassy or consulate or to access the visa website (www.visaseneal.sn) can board with the pre-visa and be granted a BIOMETRIC VISA at our international airports where they will undergo the procedure (fingerprinting of 10 fingers or toes, document checking, digital photos, etc.).
- **Standard procedure in embassies:** if you are not eligible for the e-Visa or if the type of visa you wish can not be obtained through the e-Visa procedure, you can go to the nearest Senegalese embassy with the required documents they asked you to bring.

6. COMPETITION RULES

- Grade of the event: G2;
- Best of 3 system (single elimination system);
- Video Replay;
- Contest time: 2 minutes x 3 rounds with 1 minute break;
- Seeding and drawing of lot: for every weight category, regardless of number of athletes, between 25 and 100% of the athletes will be seeded based on WT World Ranking of October 2022 (October 1st 2022);
- Win by point gap shall not be applied in semi- finals & finals during the Senegal Open.

The WT Technical Delegate has the authority to adjust the contest time & seeding rate as he sees fit.

7. COACH ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum age of 18 years;
- WT Coach Certificate Level I or above is required;
- Holder of a valid 2022 WT Global Official License;
- All coaches are required to wear formal suit such as tie, jacket, dress shirt (long or short), and trouser from semi-final matches. If any coach refuses to wear abovementioned attire, he or she won't be allowing to coach.


9. WEIGH-IN & RANDOM WEIGH-IN

- During the weigh-in, male contestants shall wear underpants and female contestants shall wear underpants and brassieres. However, contestants may weigh-in in nude if they want;
- The rate of selection for the random weigh-in shall be determined by the number of contestants in the weight category as following the criteria and subjects will be randomly selected by computerized system maximum two (2) hours before the start of the competition.

- More than 32 athletes : 20% of total
- 17-32 athletes : 6 athletes
- 9-16 athletes : 4 athletes
- 4-8 athletes : 2 athletes
- Below 4 athletes : None

10. EQUIPMENT

- PSS including E-head protectors from DAEDO GEN 2 will be provided for competitors.
- Groin/forearm/shin guards and gloves, mouth piece, PSS sensing socks, are compulsory and must be brought by the contestant for their personal use
- WT recognized OVR & IVR service provider will be used
- Participating are required to wear W.T. recognized. Competition uniforms (doboks) and WT recognized protective equipment. The latest version of WT-recognized manufacturers' list is available at the website of WT (<http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/wtpartners-wt/recognize.html>).

11. MEDICAL & DOPING CONTROL

The WT Medical Code, WT mouthguard, bracing, taping, padding and piercing rules are applicable, which all MNA participating this event must comply.

The WT anti-doping rules, and where necessary the code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competition.

WT and/or WADA may carry out random and/or targeted out-of-competition testing prior, during or after the championships;

TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption): Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the “Prohibited List” of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and Anti-Doping Code of World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) for therapeutic purposes are requested to submit TUE applications via ADAMS, together with the required medical information. If you do not have an ADAMS account yet, please contact tue@ita.sport to have it set up.

PS: All participating athletes, coaches, team officials, technical officials and participants at Senegal Open shall have mandatorily an international medical insurance that covers medical care (COVID included) and in case of emergency, repatriation to the country of origin, valid on the days present in the host country of the event. Organizing Committee shall not be responsible to cover any medical costs incurred for medical treatment before, on or after the competition or repatriation in the broadest sense of the word. All relevant documents proving that such an insurance is present, including insurance policy papers, should be taken to the event in case a medical situation occurs. Each MNA/Club, Team doctor or team medical staff must ensure their athletes and team officials have valid international health insurance that covers medical and emergency care.

12. REGISTRATION

▪ TEAM

Team entries will only be accepted through the WT GMS online registration system Simply Compete. Registration of athletes is only possible with a valid 2022 WT Global License (GAL issued by assigned GMS club, Edition and MNA Administrators only). Deadline for team registration is: **October 5th 2022 (23h59' UTC)**. Please find below the direct link to the WT GMS platform.

▪ REFEREE

Referee entries will only be accepted through the AFTU online registration system africatkdreferee.com. Appointed referees will receive from AFTU an official invitation letter after the selection process. Please find below the direct link to the registration platform.

13. PAYMENT ENTRY FEES

▪ Entry fees = **100 US\$** by participants (only athlete)

The OC shall collect the entry fees from the participating teams. Team shall pay the entry fee to the OC at the accreditation center prior to the start of the competition. Athletes shall not be allowed to compete without successful payment of entry fee.

If the athlete registered on-line does not take part in the competition, but he/she has not been removed from the list of participants before the deadline his/her team or official must fully (100%) pay his/her Entry fee for participation.

For all modifications³ (changing category & athlete replacement only) that are to be made after the deadline, an administration fee of 100 US\$ will be charged.

No refunding registration fees is allowed. All fees must be paid in DOLLAR and please ensure you pay any additional currency charges.

New registration will be not be accepted on-site.

14. AWARDS

INDIVIDUAL AWARDS BY RANK: Medals will be awarded to the top four athletes in the respective weight divisions.

- 1st place: GOLD MEDAL & CERTIFICATE
- 2nd place: SILVER MEDAL & CERTIFICATE
- 3rd place: 2 BRONZE MEDALS & CERTIFICATE

For every contestant who passed the official weigh-in:	1
For every win (including byes):	1
For every Gold Medal:	120
For every Silver Medal:	50
For every Bronze Medal:	20

Based on the point system below, teams will be ranked.

The top three (3) teams of the competition will receive trophies. Other prizes, such as the “Good Fighting Spirit or FairPlay Prize”, MVPs and Best Referees and Best Coaches may be awarded to teams and individuals.

15. PROTEST

Only federal official and/or official coach certified at least Level I is allowed to protest, immediately after the end of the contest. An amount of 200 \$US will have to be paid for each protest. The decision of the Competition Supervisory Board is final.
