4. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

Participants must be members of their National Federation, affiliated to the WT. Each participant must be a holder of a Global Athlete Licence (GAL). GAL applications and renewals can only be made through the respective WT MNA and via the Simply Compete GMS. **Applications must be made 2 months prior to these events to ensure the licence can be approved in time.**

5. COACH ELIGIBILITY

- Coaching is only allowed in sportswear (no dobok).
- Coaches must wear closed-in shoes, sandals, crocs or slides will not be permitted
- All coaches must be 18 years or older.
- Coaches must hold a valid WT Coach License Level 1 Coach certification or higher.
- Holder of a valid WT Global Coach License.
- Member of the team/club of a pertinent Member National Association, recognised by the Oceania Taekwondo Union or World Taekwondo.

6. RULES

OVR SYSTEM: Martial Events / Taekwondo Management System

EVENT RULES: The latest published World Taekwondo Poomsae Competition Rules & Interpretation shall be applied.

The WT Technical Delegate has the authority to adjust the contest time as they see fit

ANTI-DOPING: Athletes may be randomly selected to be tested.

FIELD OF PLAY: Athletes & Coaches ONLY in the Warm-Up Area & field of play.

EQUIPMENT: Athletes Wear Their Own WT APPROVED Dobok.

FREESTYLE POOMSAE MUSIC: Music must be provided on a USB at the Head of Teams Meeting. Music must not contain lyrics or any political, social, or religious content that may harm, discriminate or offend others

PROTEST: Only the coaches will be permitted to lodge official protests via the CSB, a fee of USD\$200 will apply to each protest and will not be refunded in any situation.

IDENTIFICATION: All international competitors and visitors need to hold a valid passport with an expiry date no less than 6 months after the event. All other competitors and or visitors must hold either a passport as above or a valid national identification card.

LIABILITY: All competitors, officials and visitors participate at their own risk. The MNA, Australian Taekwondo, bears no responsibility for any damages, losses, injuries, or other circumstances due to (directly or indirectly) acts of terrorism, COVID-19, or other misfortune. All participants must be covered by their own medical insurance and/or travel insurance.

Those who are not recognized as adults (under aged) by law in their own country must supply a written consent together with valid identification, signed by their parents or legal guardians.

8. EVENTS

RECOGNISED POOMSAE

- Single elimination tournament system. Two Poomsae will be performed for all rounds
- All Contestants shall perform two (2) assigned compulsory Poomsae in the preliminary and semi-final rounds and two (2) assigned compulsory Poomsae in the final round. All contestants will compete in the preliminary round. The highest 50% scores from the preliminary round will advance to the semi-finals. At the end of the semi-final round the highest eight (8) scoring contestants will advance to the final round. The highest score in four (4) contestants will be awarded medals (1st, 2nd, 3rd, 3rd) based on scores
- Divisions with fewer than 20 contestants will start with the semi-final round
- Divisions with fewer than 9 contestants will start with the final round
- Designated Poomsae forms will be drawn at the Poomsae Head of Team Meeting and posted online after the meeting.

FREESTYLE POOMSAE

- Poomsae Freestyle: Cut-off system for all Freestyle categories (Single Final Round)
- Freestyle athletes need to submit a printout copy of their performance plan using the Freestyle Poomsae Performance Plan Form on the day of registration ([download here](#))
- The OC may change this due to organisational matters. Scoring shall be made in accordance with the rules of World Taekwondo.

9. SEEDING

World Taekwondo Poomsae World Ranking Bylaw will be applied

Seeding will be done for Recognized Under 30, Recognized Under 40, and Over 17 Freestyle divisions for Para Poomsae

All other poomsae divisions will not be seeded

10. TECHNICAL MEETING & DRAWING OF LOTS

The Technical Meeting will be held one (1) day prior to the start of the competition

Poomsae Draws/Brackets will be completed at the Head of Team meeting and posted on the event website and AT social media accounts.

11. TROPHIES

TEAM TROPHY: Team Awards will be presented to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place teams for Senior Kyorugi and WT Poomsae competition. An Overall Best Team trophy for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams will be presented at the end of the corresponding day. Team awards are calculated based on points accumulated by players representing clubs/ nations.

- 1st Place 9 points
- 2nd Place 6 points
- 3rd Place 3 points
- 4th Place 2 points

If there is a tie in overall team points, the number of gold medals will be considered.

12. INTERNATIONAL CLASSIFICATION

Para Poomsae

Please Note: International Classification of all Para Poomsae (P20 P30 P50 P70 Sport Classes) athletes will take place on Wednesday, 17th June 2026 at the Southport Church of Christ - Address: 1 Griffith Way, Southport QLD 4215 from 9am.

All teams should prepare their travel for their athletes to be available for International Classification on these dates.

WT Para Taekwondo Department will publish the Classification time schedule after the deadline expires. The details on each sport class can be found in the WT Athlete Classification Rules on the WT website.

Medical Diagnostics Form through World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS):

Medical Diagnostic Form must be submitted for any NEW (N) or REVIEW (R) athlete registered for the tournament. Deadline for uploading MDFs to the WTCS is on the registration deadline on June 8th. If no MDF has been submitted by this time the athlete will not be called for classification and cannot compete.

Following IPC Guidelines on data protection concerning athletes and personal classification information, World Taekwondo has in connection with IPC created the World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS). World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS) is the new WT online registration tool for MNAs to register their new athletes and add Medical Diagnostic Forms (MDF) and pictures to be seen by the UHC Assessors to determine if the new athlete is eligible for Para Taekwondo and has an Underlying Health Condition. All athletes in the WTCS will require a WT Licence Number (GAL).

WTCS Account Policy – Each Member Federation must internally designate exactly one (1) primary user responsible for WTCS Account.

13. TRANSPORT & ACCOMMODATION

Round trip airfare of each participant and/or official shall be borne by each individual. Due to the large number of participants expected, the Organising Committee **WILL NOT BE** providing any ground transport to/from the airport or to/from the competition venue.

Accommodation charges for room and board of athletes and official teams shall be borne by each individual or team. The Organising Committee bears no financial responsibility.

Teams/athletes should not book flights for competition days. No allowances will be made for athletes to fight early if they have booked a flight on fight day. Athletes will need to withdraw if they need to leave a competition day early, and **No Refund** will be provided.

For information on suggested hotels, please see the back of this outline. The Organising Committee does not guarantee any advertised fees or charges by any hotels.

14. COMMUNICATION

All official documents, including the entry pack, drawsheet and results will be published on the Event website. Any information published in any other location cannot be guaranteed as official.

Official documents will not be emailed directly to Coaches, but coaches will receive a direct email from AT when the documents are available on the website. This is to limit issues around email delivery with attachments, incorrect email addresses, and other issues.

During the competition, AT will use the event WhatsApp channel to communicate live updates such as court changes, changes to the schedule and other 'live' information. These updates will also be shared on AT social channels where appropriate.

These updates will not be shared on the AT website due to the number and frequency of updates.

15. INTERNATIONAL REFEREES

Appointment of all International Referees will be made via the Organising Committee. The Organising Committee will provide a daily per diem of USD\$ 150, accommodation, board, and transport for each selected International Referee. Arrival/Departure, Check-In/Check-Out dates will be forwarded to each referee upon acceptance of the appointment.

15. VISA REQUIREMENTS

The Australian Department of Foreign Affairs advises that those participants requiring a Visa for entry into Australia should apply at least 1 month prior to arrival.

The visa invitation letter for each registered individual will be automatically generated from WT GMS platform if the visa is requested during the registration for the event. All members who need entry visa to Australia must be registered for the event in GMS. You must then use this letter to apply for your or your team member's visa.
