QUALIFICATION

In accordance with Article 4 of the World Para Taekwondo Competition Rules, the contestant must be:

1. Holder of Nationality of the participating team
 - 1.1 Athletes with a refugee status issued by either governmental authorities in the country of residence or the UNHCR may be entered into tournaments and championships under WT flag based on prior approval from WT.
2. An athlete recommended by a WT recognized Member National Association
3. Holder of a WT recognized Dan or 5-1 Geup / Holder of a Para Taekwondo Dan issued by the WT or MNA
4. Holder of a WT Global Athlete Licence
5. Kyorugi Contestant shall be at least 16 years old (2010) in the year of the pertinent tournament.
6. Athlete must undergo International Classification in accordance with the World Para Taekwondo Athlete Classification Rules and be assigned a Sport Class and Sport Class Status prior to the tournament. Athletes found Not Eligible (NE) or with a Classification Not Complete (CNC) will not be able to compete.

COACH ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

In accordance with the World Para Taekwondo Administration regulations of International Para Taekwondo Coaches, all coaches officiating at the Muju Taekwondowon 2026 11th World Para Taekwondo Championships need to be a certified World Taekwondo International Coach Level 2.

NOTE: Only coaches with a World Taekwondo International Coach Certificate Level 2 will be allowed to coach athletes at the Muju Taekwondowon 2026 11th World Para Taekwondo Championships. Make sure to attend the courses offered online at the start and middle of every month. Registrations must be completed through the WT GMS.

TEAM DOCTOR/PHYSICIAN ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

In order to receive accreditation as team doctor/physician, all doctors and physicians must attend the medical meeting on November 19th, 2026.

COMPETITION RULES AND COMPETITION FORMAT

Kyorugi K40 Sport Class

The latest updated World Para Taekwondo Competition Rules will be implemented for competition in the K41 and K44 Sport Classes at the Muju Taekwondowon 2026 11th World Para Taekwondo Championships.

*NOTE that Article 10.5 of the World Para Taekwondo Competition Rules will be in effect. Athletes that fail weigh-in shall be **disqualified**. All athletes are required to be registered in the correct weight category by the registration deadline. **Weight categories will not be changed in the case the athlete does not pass weigh-in.**

METHOD OF COMPETITION

Kyorugi K40 Sport Class

The Competitions in the K41 and K44 Sport Classes at the Muju Taekwondowon 2026 11th World Para Taekwondo Championships will be held in a best of 3 round system. [2 minutes x 2 (3) rounds with 1 minute break.

PSS

Muju Taekwondowon 2026 11th World Para Taekwondo Championships will use **KPNP K2** Protector and Scoring System (PSS). The following sizes and hit-levels will be implemented.

Note – Hit-levels may be adjusted based on the decision of the Technical Delegate.

ATHLETE UNIFORMS

Kyorugi K40 Sport Class

Athlete uniforms shall be modified in accordance with the World Para Taekwondo Uniform Specification Guide.

The Organizing Committee will provide Protector and Scoring System (PSS) and Head protectors to the participating contestants. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthpieces, gloves, sensing socks (KPNP K2) and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.

Before entering the field of play, all contestants will proceed to the inspection desk for inspection of their competition uniforms and protective equipment. **Any contestant who wears unofficial competition uniforms or protective equipment will not be permitted to compete.**

ENTRIES

Every WT Member National Association may enter **one (1)** athletes into each weight category at the Muju Taekwondowon 2026 11th World Para Taekwondo Championships.

- i. Athletes and team officials registered online may be replaced without penalty before the close of the final online registration period.
- ii. Registration fee will not be charged for cancellation of participation before the close of the final online registration period.
- iii. Registration fee must be paid in full in case of cancellation of participation for registered athletes after the close of the final online registration deadline or in case of no-show. The applicable registration fee to be paid may vary depending on the registration period in which the athlete was registered.
- iv. Team officials can ONLY hold one position, holding multiple positions (roles) is not allowed.
- v. Additional Penalty: Penalty of US\$100 per person shall be paid to the Organizing Committee at the accreditation center in the following cases
 - A team official who is not registered online but seeks accreditation onsite.
 - Any changes or additions that are made to a team entry list (except for contestants) after the close of the final online registration period will incur a US\$100 penalty. This penalty will be considered the onsite fee for approved changes or additions to the team entry list.
 - Any changes or additions that are made to a team entry list (except for contestants) after the online registration has closed MUST be approved in person by the Head of Team or Manager. If no Head of Team or Manager is registered for the event, then written confirmation from the MNA President, Vice President, Secretary General or GMS Administrator will be required.
 - Re-print Penalty: Penalty of US\$50 per accreditation shall be paid to the Organizing Committee at the accreditation center for any re-printing of accreditation cards due to loss of accreditation.

*** Any WT Global Licence registrations completed on site will incur a US\$50 onsite processing fee per WT Global Licence required.**

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

Athletes shall not be allowed to compete without successful payment of entry fee to the Organizing Committee.

- C. Entry Registration: **Entry will only be accepted through the WT online registration system - WT GMS.**
- D. Ground transportation will be provided for national teams on arrival and departure free of charge, only for teams who book via the official event agent and provided that the Organizing Committee has been informed of the date, time, and flight number of the national team's arrival and departure at the latest by **October 23, at 23:59 CET**. Daily transportation is also provided in Muju between official hotels and venues for athlete training, registration, head of team meeting and competition days.

LICENCE AND ONLINE REGISTRATION

WT Global License Registration

All Athletes and Team officials must **FIRST** be registered with a valid **2026** WT License. You will not be able to register without renewing the license for **2026!**

WT Online Registration

National Team Entry will only be accepted through the WT online registration system and registration is only possible with a valid WT Global License. National Team GMS administrators will be notified via email once online registration is open.

Registration instructions

Kyorigi: Athletes that have already been classified should register in the confirmed sport class and weight category where they wish to compete. Athletes that have previously not gone through (New "N") athlete classification and been assigned a sport class and a sport class status shall register in the desired weight category but in the K40 Sport Class.

SPORT CLASSES

K41



Bilateral Amputation above or through the elbow. NO elbow joint can be present on either sides for acquired amputation

Bilateral Dysmelia in which the length of each upper limb $\leq (0.193 \times \text{standing height})$.

BOTH ARMS MUST MEET MINIMUM IMPAIRMENT CRITERIA (MIC)

K44



Unilateral Amputation, through or above wrist (i.e., no carpal bones present in affected limb). Arthrodesis of the wrist joints are Not Eligible (NE).

Unilateral Dysmelia, the length of the affected arm measured from acromion to longest part of the stump is equal in length or shorter than the unaffected arm measured from acromion to radial styloid.

Bilateral Amputation, below the elbow but above or through wrists (NO carpal bones present in either wrists).

Bilateral Dysmelia, the length of each arm is equal to or shorter than $\leq 0.337 \times$ standing height. Only one arm can meet the criteria.

Unilateral or Bilateral
Impaired muscle power (Grade 2 muscle power or below) in shoulder abduction and/or flexion.

Unilateral or Bilateral
Impaired muscle power (Grade 3 muscle power or below) in elbow flexion and/or extension.

Unilateral or Bilateral
Elbow flexion contracture from arthrodesis/ankylosis of a joint with traumatic soft tissue loss or bony joint damage; affected arm length is measured from acromion to longest finger is shorter than or equal to $\leq$ the unaffected arm measured from acromion to radial styloid with the elbow extended passively to the longest.

INTERNATIONAL ATHLETE CLASSIFICATION

The term “Classification” refers to a structure for Competition to ensure that an Athlete’s Impairment is relevant to sport performance, and that Athletes compete equitably with each other. The purpose of Classification is to define who is eligible to compete in Para Taekwondo and to group athletes in sports classes for competition in Kyorugi.

MEDICAL DIAGNOSTIC FORM (MDF) for K40

The Medical Diagnostic Form (MDF) is to be completed in English by the athlete’s individual physician or physiotherapist.

The completed form must be submitted by **October 21, 2026** before the athlete undergoes athlete evaluation. This applies to all athletes with a physical impairment competing in WT. Depending on the athlete’s health condition and impairment, additional medical information is to be attached to this form. Please consult the WT Classification rules for a list of eligible impairments and underlying health conditions for Kyorugi.

NOTE – Failure to submit MDF and medical information can lead to your athlete not being able to be classified and receiving a “Classification Not Complete”, “CNC”. The athlete will then not be able to compete at the event.

WORLD TAEKWONDO CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM (WTCS)

World Taekwondo Classification System (WTCS) is the WT online registration tool for MNAs to register their new athletes and add Medical Diagnostic Forms (MDF) and pictures to be seen by the WT Classification Evaluation Group to determine if the new athlete is eligible for Para Taekwondo and meets Minimum Impairment Criteria (MIC). All athletes in the WTCS will require a WT License Number (GAL).

Fill out and submit the MNA Account Request form to the Para Taekwondo Department at para-tkd@worldtaekwondo.org. Username and password will then be sent to the communicated email address.

NOTE – Failure to submit MDF and medical information can lead to your athlete not being able to be classified and receiving a “Classification Not Complete”, “CNC”. The athlete will then not be able to compete at the event.

**WTCS Account Policy – Each Member Federation must internally designate exactly one (1) primary user responsible for WTCS Account.*

CLASSIFICATION SCHEDULE & LOCATION

Classification schedule will be sent out following close of online registration. Classification will take place on November 18-19, 2026. Changes to classification schedule will not be made once announced.

GUIDELINES FOR INTERNATIONAL ATHLETE CLASSIFICATION

The athlete should be wearing sport clothes (track suit). The athlete also needs to bring their uniform (dobok) and all personal protective equipment. The athlete should also bring any relevant medical information to classification.

Teams should have with them a translator who has good understanding of English.

The athlete should always do their best on the tests and exercises requested by the International Classifiers.

GLOBAL RANKING

The Muju Taekwondowon 2026 11th World Para Taekwondo Championships will hold a World Para Taekwondo **G14** ranking status. Competitions will be held in the Kyorugi “K”, K41 and K44 Sport Classes in five (5) men’s and five (5) women’s weight categories.

In accordance with Article 6.4 of the World Para Taekwondo Competition Rules, “all competitions recognized by WT shall be formed with participation of no less than three (3) countries. Official results from Para Taekwondo Competitions with less than three (3) countries participating shall not be recognized by WT. **Any Sport Class and weight category with less than three (3) athletes from two (2) countries shall not be recognized in the official results.**

WORLD PARA TAEKWONDO RANKING AND SEEDING

Seeding for the Muju Taekwondowon 2026 11th World Para Taekwondo Championships will be based on the November 2026 World Para Taekwondo Ranking (including all results and deductions until October 31, 2026).

WEIGH-IN

Please note that Article 10.5 of the WT Para Taekwondo Competition Rules will be in effect. Athletes that fail weigh-in shall be disqualified. All athletes are required to be registered in the correct weight division by the end of registration deadline. Weight division will not be changed in the case the athlete does not pass weigh in!

Weigh-in will be held in the venue. Please see the event schedule.

RANDOM WEIGH-IN

Random weigh-in with 5% allowance will be held in the morning of each competition day in accordance with the schedule. A set percentage (%) to be announced at the head of team meeting) of athletes from each weight category will be randomly drawn and announced in accordance with the event schedule. "Over" weight categories are not subject to random weigh-in.

Random weigh-in will take place one (1) hour before the start of each competition day in the venue.

Random weigh-in lists will be published on the World Taekwondo website and World Para Taekwondo Facebook page each day in accordance with the event schedule.

HEAD OF TEAM MEETING

The Head of Team meeting for the Kyorugi Competitions will be held on November 19, 2026, at 18:00. Each participating team may send two (2) persons to attend the head of team meeting.

During the meeting important information regarding the competitions, procedures and competition rules will be shared with the teams as well as the drawing of lots for day 1 of competition.

All teams should send representatives to this meeting.

DRAWING OF LOTS & PUBLICATION

The drawing of lots will take place after Athlete Classification and weigh-in have been completed.

The draw for Competition Day 1 will be conducted during the Head of Team Meeting.

The draws for Competition Days 2 and 3 will be conducted at the competition venue on the respective preceding competition days and will be published on the World Taekwondo website no later than 18:00.

All Athletes with World Para Taekwondo Ranking points will be seeded in accordance with the World Para Taekwondo Ranking Bylaw based on the November 2026 World Para Taekwondo Ranking (including all results and deductions until October 31, 2026).

The draw will be published on the OVR provider website as well as the World Taekwondo website and World Para Taekwondo Facebook page.

BROADCAST & LIVESTREAM

The Muju Taekwondowon 2026 11th World Para Taekwondo Championships will be livestreamed on the World Taekwondo Youtube page. The schedule for the live stream of the Muju Taekwondowon 2026 11th World Para Taekwondo Championships will be published ahead of the event.
